

Issues:

On the basis of pleadings of the parties the following issues are framed:

- i. Whether the suit as framed is maintainable?
- ii. Whether the plaintiff has got any cause of action or right to sue?
- iii. Whether the suit is barred by Law of limitation, principles of estoppel, waiver and acquiescence?
- iv. Whether the suit is properly valued and court fee paid thereupon is sufficient?
- v. Whether the suit is bad for non-joinder and misjoinder of parties?
- vi. Whether the suit is hit by section 34 of specific relief act?
- vii. Whether the present suit is liable to be stayed under Section 10 of the CPC, pending the final adjudication of the Second Appeal involving the same parties and subject matter?
- viii. Whether the land described in Schedule 'B' was lawfully settled in favor of the plaintiff's ancestors by way of a Settlement Patta, and whether the plaintiff holds valid right, title, and interest over the same?
- ix. Whether the plaintiff is in peaceful and continuous possession of the suit property and is entitled to a decree for confirmation of possession?
- x. Whether a survey by a Survey Knowing Commissioner (SKPC) is necessary to measure the property and demarcate the boundaries by erecting pillars at the four corners?
- xi. To what other relief or reliefs, the plaintiffs are entitled for?
