27.07.2026	Both parties are not on attendance. On repeated call neither parties nor their Ld. Counsels appeared. The record reflects that the case was fixed for exparte plaintiff evidence since 21.03.24. Plaintiff is not proceeding further in compliance of the previous court order. Despite repeated directions given by this Court to the Plaintiff(s) to do proper <i>pairvi</i> the plaintiff is not on attendance since 12.11.24. Upon perusal of the record, The record reflects that the case was specifically fixed for compliance with the Court's order to be present and adduce evidence. Despite repeated directions and opportunities afforded by this Court to the Plaintiff(s) to properly attend to the matter, complete the necessary 'Pairvi' (prosecution/follow-up), and comply with the previous court orders, neither the Plaintiff(s) nor their Counsel appeared today to proceed further. The Court notes that the Plaintiff(s) have failed to appear and proceed with the matter, and is not on attendance for several consecutive dates. The Court had previously granted a last chance to the Plaintiff(s) to prosecute the matter with due diligence and to do <i>parivi</i>. As the 'Master of the Case,' the onus lies solely upon the Plaintiff(s) to take all necessary steps for the litigation's advancement. The persistent and unexplained default in appearance and failure to appear clearly demonstrates a lack of interest in pursuing the instant case. In light of the Plaintiffs' persistent default in appearance and evident lack of interest in prosecuting the suit with due diligence, the Court finds that the Plaintiff(s) have failed to prosecute the suit. The instant case is, therefore, DISMISSED IN DEFAULT FOR NON-PROSECUTION. Office Clerk is directed to deposit the record in the record room within stipulated period as per law.
