C.S Bharadwaj Vs. Arun Kumari P Jha

ORDER BELOW APPLICATION EXH.14

This is an application filed for granting an interim compensation u/sec.143-A of the Negotiable Instrument Act.

2. Accused failed to file reply despite giving more than sufficient opportunity.

3. Heard advocate Mr. Ajit Singh for complainant. Advocate for accused absent.

4. Complainant has filed evidence affidavit on 24.09.2023. It is contended on behalf of complainant that disputed cheque is issued by the accused for returning the amount of consideration paid to the accused for purchasing flat. Accused has not disputed her signature on cheque Exh.18. Even accused has not replied statutory notice dated 14.01.2022. In the facts and circumstances, there is sufficient material on record for succeeding during the trial by the complainant.

5. Accused prolonging the trial. Therefore, this is a fit case to invoke powers conferred upon this court under section 143-A of the Act considering right of complainant to have a speedy trial. Hence, I pass following order.

ORDER

- 1) The application is allowed.
- 2) The accused is directed to make payment of 20% of cheque amount within 60 days from today to

the complainant as an interim compensation.

- 3) Order dictated and pronounced in open court.
- 4) Order be uploaded on Court Web Portal.
