An application seeking exemption from personal appearance of the JD along with photocopy of medical prescription and vakalatnama are filed on behalf of JD.

Intern states that JD is not well, therefore, he could not appear and seeks adjournment.

Ld. counsel for the DH states that JD has not made any payment till date and on 16.06.2026 when the Bailiff visited the premises of the JD he assured that he would deposit the decretal amount and would also appear before the court but till date neither he appeared nor made payment. Ld. counsel for the DH further states that warrants of arrest may kindly be issued against the JD .

Heard. Record perused.

As per Bailiff report, Bailiff visited the premises of the JD on 16.06.2026 for attachment of his movable assets. The JD was found there and refused to give decretal amount and told that he would appear before the court and also deposit the decretal amount but the JD has not made any payment till date nor appeared before the court on 10.07.2026, hence, there is no merit in the application seeking exemption from personal appearance of the JD and the same is dismissed.

Issue fresh warrants of attachment against the JDs

qua the movable and immovable assets of the JD in the sum of decretal amount as per list on filing of PF and subject to filing of affidavit that there is no stay against the decree by Appellate Court. Steps be taken within three days.

DH is directed to appear before Ld. ACJ (Shahdara) for appointment of Bailiff on **14.09.2026**.
