Accused Ravindra Yadav @ Loha Yadav @ Birendra Singh produced from custody through V.C.

Case called out.

Learned Counsel for petitioner pressed the bail petition dated 18.02.2026 filed on behalf of petitioner named above, who voluntarily surrendered before the Court on 18.02.2026 and since then he is in custody in connection with **Brahampur P.S. Case No. 42/2008**, registered u/s 395, 412 of I.P.C.

Copy of bail petition has already been served to the Ld. Addl. P.P. for the State.

Learned Counsel for petitioner submits that, petitioner is quite innocent and earlier he was on bail. On 19.04.2022, the petitioner was represented u/s 317 Cr.P.C. but the same was rejected by this Court and his bail bond was cancelled. The petitioner is a driver and lives in Kolkata for his livelihood. The petitioner undertakes to remain present on each and every date. Therefore, prayed to release the petitioner on bail.

Learned Additional P.P. for the State vehemently opposes the bail petition on the ground that, the petitioner has misused the privilege of bail twice.

Perused the case record, from perusal of same it transpires that, earlier the petitioner was granted bail by this learned C.J.M, Buxar on 26.05.2008 during investigation. The charge has been framed in present case on 21.04.2009 but the petitioner remained absent due to which his bail bond was cancelled on 19.04.2022

and N.B.W. was issued against him on 20.07.2022. Thereafter, process u/s 82 Cr.P.C. was issued against him on 26.07.2025. Moreover, the petitioner voluntarily surrendered before the Court on 18.02.2026.

In the aforesaid facts and circumstances, the present bail petition of petitioner named above is hereby **allowed**. Let, the petitioner named above be released on bail on furnishing **bail bond of Rs.10,000/-** with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of this Court with condition that,

1. The petitioner shall deposit cost of Rs. 5000/- in the account of Victim Compensation Fund and shall furnish the receipt of the same at the time of furnishing of bail bond.
2. The petitioner shall be physically present on each and every date fixed and if he remain absent on two consecutive dates without proper explanation, the bail bond of petitioner shall be cancelled.
