The above mentioned Anticipatory Bail Petitions filed on behalf of petitioners named above, who are apprehending their arrest in connection with **Dumraon P.S. Case No. 13/2026**, registered u/s 115(2), 126(2), 110, 3(5) of B.N.S is put up and moved today.

Copy of bail petition has already been served to the Ld. P.P. for the prosecution.

Learned Counsels for the petitioners certifies that, no other bail petition has ever been filed on behalf of these petitioners in this matter either before this Court or before any Superior Court. The petitioners have got no criminal antecedent. Prosecution has no objection to the submissions.

The Counsel further submits that petitioners are quite innocent and have been falsely implicated in the present case due to village politics. No case under any Sections of F.I.R. is made out against the petitioners. The petitioners have not committed any offence. The allegations leveled against the petitioners are false, concocted and exaggerated one. There is no ingredient of Section 110 B.N.S. in written petition of the informant. It is a case of Section 115(2) B.N.S. The petitioners are have got clean antecedent and they are ready to co-operate in investigation and trial of the case. Therefore, petitioners deserve to be enlarged on anticipatory bail.

Learned P.P. for the State opposes the Bail Petition on the ground of nature and seriousness of offence.

Prosecution case in brief, according to written petition of informant Sonu

Kumar is that on 18.01.2026 at about 08.30 A.M. while he was eating litti at the shop of Kanhaiya Gond and he was making payment of litti online. The petitioners along with co-accused Rakesh Kumar, Rajesh Kumar and Kundan Kumar attacked him with lathi-danda and iron rod resulting causing injuries on back of his head for which he got himself treated at Sub-Divisional Hospital, Dumraon.

Heard learned Counsels of both sides and perused the photostat of case diary written upto para 60. Para 26 of case diary shows that informant Sonu Kumar sustained hairline undisplaced fracture of nasal bone on left side. The case record shows that there is no specific allegation against these petitioners. The Supervision note mentioned in para no.31 of the case diary shows that there is prior enmity between Gautam Kumar and Sonu Kumar (informant). The witnesses in para 43 and 44 of case diary have stated that at the relevant time the informant Sonu Kumar was abusing people in intoxicated state and after sometime he brought lathi to assault them but the lathi was snatched by the people present there and they assaulted him. Para 28 of case diary shows that the petitioners have got no criminal antecedent.

Thus, considering the submissions of learned Counsels of both sides, facts and circumstances of the case, the anticipatory bail petitions of the petitioners **Dilip Kumar and Gautam Kumar** are hereby **allowed** on furnishing bail bond of **Rs.10,000/- each with two sureties of the like amount each** to the satisfaction of the learned Trial Court in the event of their arrest or surrender **within 04 weeks** period from today subject to conditions as laid down u/s u/s 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita (B.N.S.S.) [earlier 438(2) Cr.P.C.]

Accordingly, both the Anticipatory Bail Petition A.B.P. No. 246/2026 and 295/2026 are hereby **allowed**.
