Anticipatory Bail Petition filed on behalf of petitioners named above, who are apprehending their arrest in connection with **Nawanagar P.S. Case No. 91/2025** registered u/s 126(2), 115(2), 117(2), 74, 109, 351, 324(4), 3(5) of B.N.S. 2023 is put up and moved today.

Copy of bail petition has already been served to the Ld. P.P. for the prosecution.

Learned Counsel for the petitioners certifies that, earlier the petitioners had filed their anticipatory bail vide A.B.P. No 140/2026 which was dismissed as withdrawn. No other bail petition has ever been filed on behalf of the petitioners in this matter either before this Court or before any Superior Court. The petitioners have got no criminal antecedent. Prosecution has no objection to the submissions.

The Counsel further submits that the petitioners are quite innocent and have been falsely implicated in this case. There is no specific allegation against the petitioners. The informant has not mentioned who assaulted whom. The fact of the matter is that on the date of occurrence informant and his family members brutally assaulted petitioners and others regarding which Nawanagar P.S. Case No. 92/2025 was lodged and to save himself

from that case, informant has filed a false case. The co-accused who were arrested by police have been granted regular bail by this Court in B.P. No. 568/2025. The informant and other victims have not sustained such injuries which may attract Section 109 B.N.S. The informant has not mentioned anything about any attempt by petitioners to outrage the modesty of any female and rest sections are bailable in nature. The petitioners are ready to furnish bail bonds to the satisfaction of this court. Therefore, petitioners deserve to be enlarged on anticipatory bail.

Learned P.P. for the State vehemently opposes the Bail Petition on the ground of nature and seriousness of offence.

Prosecution case in brief, according to written petition of informant Lalita Devi is that, on 21.10.2025 at about 07.00 am petitioner Raviranjn Kumar along with co-accused Chandan Kumar, Saroj Kumar, Kamlesh Kumar, Jaiprakash Kumar came and started abusing and assaulting her. When she forbade them from pounding cowdung in the street. The petitioners namely Sudarshan Singh, Surendra Singh, Ashok Singh, Dharmendra Kumar and co-accused Surendra Kumar, Nitish Kumar, Baijnath Singh, Mulayam Singh, Dadan Kumar, Madan Kumar, Pintu Singh, Chandra Bhushan Singh,, Rakesh Kumar and Rajesh Singh came damaged her vehicle. On objection they assaulted and injured head of informant's son and husband.

Heard learned Counsels of both parties and perused the photostat of case diary written upto para 100. The informant in her re-statement recorded in para 2 of the case diary has stated that in the occurrence her son (Surendra Kumar), husband (Lalji Singh) and nephew Arvind Singh sustained injuries. Para 37, 38 and 39 of case diary shows that Surendra Kumar, Lalji Singh and Arvind Singh have sustained simple injuries. There is no specific allegation against the petitioners. The Supervision Note of S.D.P.O. Dumraon mentioned in para 52 of case diary shows that the case has been found true u/s 126(2), 115(2), 117(2), 74, 351, 352(2), 324(4), 3(5) of B.N.S. Para 31 of case diary shows that petitioners have got no criminal antecedent.

Thus, considering the submissions of learned Counsels of both sides and facts and circumstances of the case, the anticipatory bail petition of the petitioners namely **Ravi Ranjaj Kumar, Ashok Singh @ Ashok Kumar, Ramuna Singh, Dharmendra Kumar Singh @ Dharmendra Kumar, Surendra Singh and Sudarshan Singh** is hereby **allowed** on furnishing bail bond of **Rs.10,000/-each with two sureties of the like amount each** to the satisfaction of the learned Trial Court in the event of their arrest or surrender **within 04 weeks** period from today subject to conditions as laid down u/s s 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita (B.N.S.S.) [earlier 438(2) Cr.P.C.].
