ORDER

21-04-2026

Present regular bail application has been filed on behalf of the above named applicants, who are in judicial custody in connection with Nawanagar P.S. case no. 29 /2026 is put up and moved today.

A copy of the bail application has already been served upon the Ld. Public Prosecutor for the State.

The Ld. counsel for the applicants submits that the applicants are innocent and have been implicated in a false case. It is further submitted that the applicants have neither filed any application for regular bail nor for anticipatory bail in any court, and no such application is pending anywhere. In connection with this incident, a counter case has also been filed by the applicants. The applicants have no criminal antecedent and are in custody since 09-03-2026.

The Ld. Public Prosecutor for the State has vehemently opposed the bail application and prayed for its rejection.

Brief facts of the case, as alleged by the informant, are that on 08.03.2026 at about 11 a.m. informant was going home after submitting application of assault in Nawanagar P.S.. In the way some persons namely Sudip Kumar, Pritesh Kumar, Sandeep Kumar, Ritesh Kumar @ Rinku, Harishankar Prasad, Hareram Prasad stopped him and hit him and his nephew on the head with iron rods and other weapons due to which head injury caused to the informant and his nephew. When his brother and mother went to save them then all accused persons beaten them. All accused persons threatened to kill them.

Perused the materials available on record, and considered the rival submissions advanced by the Ld. Counsel for both sides. It reveals that statements of two witnesses besides the informant have been recorded in para 8 and 9 of the

case diary and they have supported the incident and also told that the reason behind it was the ongoing dispute between the two parties. In connection with this incident, a counter case has also been filed by the applicants, whose Nawanagar P.S. Case no. is 30/2026. In the injury report, the doctor described the injury sustained by the injured as of simple nature. It is also mentioned in the case diary that the applicants have no criminal antecedent other than this case. Applicants are in custody since 09.03.2026.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, and taking into account the period of custody undergone by the applicants and without expressing any opinion on merit of the case this Court finds it justified to enlarge the applicants on bail. Accordingly, let the applicants, be released on bail in connection with **Nawanagar P.S. case no. 29/2026** furnishing bail bonds of **Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties** of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the concerned Court subject to the following conditions:-

- I. The applicants will remain present on each and every date fixed by the concerned court, if so required by the Ld. court.
- II. The applicants shall not tamper with the witnesses or evidences in any manner.
- III. The applicants will co-operate with the police in the investigation and will appear whenever summoned by the investigating officer.
