Regular Bail Petition filed on behalf of petitioner namely **Rajindra Yadav @ Rajendra Yadav**, S/o Bhailal Yadav who is in custody since 14.03.2026 in connection with **Nainizore P.S. Case No.22/2026** registered u/s 126(2), 109, 308(3), 118(1), 352, 351(2) of B.N.S. is put up and moved today.

Copy of bail petition has already been served to the Learned Public Prosecutor for the State.

Sri Arun Kumar Rai learned Counsel for the petitioner certifies that no other bail petition has ever been filed on behalf of the petitioner in this matter either before this Court or before any Superior Court. The petitioner has got no criminal antecedent. Prosecution has no objection to the submissions.

The Counsel further submits that, petitioner is quite innocent and has been falsely implicated in this case due to land dispute. The petitioner has not committed any act to attract Section 109 of B.N.S. All injuries are simple in nature. Therefore, petitioner deserves to be enlarged on bail.

Sri Kedar Nath Tiwari, Learned Public Prosecutor for the State strongly opposes the Bail Petition on the ground of nature and seriousness of offence.

Prosecution case in brief according to written petition of informant Sunil Yadav is that on 12.03.2026 at about 01.00 P.M. while the 5 years old son of the informant was returning home from his school, the petitioner pushed him with an intention to kill him. When informant's wife came to the rescue, the petitioner started abusing her as well. It is alleged by the informant that the petitioner abuses and assaults the informant and his family members regularly. Earlier as well, informant registered a case vide Nainijore P.S. Case No.12 of 2026. Informant has further alleged that this incident took place because of an existing land dispute between him and the petitioner.

Heard learned Counsels of both sides and perused the photostat of

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case diary written upto para 30. Para 29 of case diary shows that injured Sunny Kumar sustained simple injuries. Para 25 of case diary shows that petitioner has got no criminal antecedent. Para 16 of case diary shows that, petitioner is in custody since 14.03.2026.

Thus, considering submissions of learned Counsels and the aforementioned facts and circumstances of the case as well as period of detention, this Court is inclined to release the petitioner on bail. Let, the petitioner namely **Rajindra Yadav @ Rajendra Yadav** be released on regular bail on furnishing **bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each** to the satisfaction of Learned Trial Court.
