Anticipatory Bail Petition filed on behalf of petitioner named above, who is apprehending his arrest in connection with **Buxar (Mahila) P.S. Case No.23/2025** registered u/s 115(2), 85, 303(2), 3(5) of B.N.S. and 3/4 D.P. Act is put up and moved today.

Copy of the bail petition has already been served to the Learned Public Prosecutor for the State.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner certifies that no other bail petition has ever been filed on behalf of the petitioner in this matter either before this Court or before any Superior Court. The petitioner has no criminal antecedent. Prosecution has no objection to the submissions.

The Counsel further submits that the petitioner is quite innocent and has committed no offence to attract the provisions of law rather he has been falsely implicated in present case. The allegation levelled against the petitioner are entirely false and factually incorrect. The petitioner has neither demanded anything in dowry nor tortured the informant for the same. During investigation, the petitioner was granted privilege of Section 41 (1) of Cr.P.C. and he did not misuse the same. The investigation against the petitioner is over and charge-sheet has been submitted. The petitioner undertake to co-operate in the trial of the case and is also ready to keep his wife with honor and dignity. Therefore, petitioner deserves to be enlarged on regular bail.

Learned Public Prosecutor for the State opposes the Bail Petition on the ground of nature and seriousness of offence. He further submits that Cognizance in

the case has been taken by the learned Trial Court on 28.07.2025. The petitioner has been summoned in the case and the record is pending for appearance of petitioner.

Learned Counsel for informant informed the Court that the matter was sent to Mediation Center, Buxar but the mediation between parties failed.

Prosecution case in brief according to typed petition of the informant Anju is that, her marriage was solemnized with Shashi Kumar/petitioner on 24.04.2022. Her husband is Junior Engineer in A.A.I. at Salem Airport, Tamil Nadu. After marriage, she went to her matrimonial home where she used to live with her Father-in-law Brij Bihari Ram, Mother-in-law Mana Devi, brothers-in-law namely Dinesh Kumar and Mukeh Kumar. Her mother-in-law Mana Devi used to insult her before others. Her husband and mother-in-law started torturing her and demanded a Creta car in dowry. Her husband/petitioner took her to Salem, where he used to compare her with other women and insult her. When she expressed her willingness to do job, they stopped her from it. The petitioner ousted her in April, 2023. Her father tried to persuade the petitioner but it went in vain. After an year, the informant herself went to her matrimonial home but the behaviour of the petitioner and other co-accused persons did not change. On 26.10.2024 the petitioner again ousted her.

Heard learned Counsels of both the parties and perused the trial court record. The record shows that learned Trial Court has taken cognizance of offence u/s 115(2), 85, 303(2), 3(5) of B.N.S. and 3/4 D.P. Act. against the petitioner and other co-accused persons on 28.07.2025. Since, then the record is pending for appearance of petitioner.

Thus, considering the submissions of both sides and facts and circumstances of the case, I am not inclined to release the petitioner on anticipatory bail. Accordingly, present anticipatory bail petition of petitioner **Shashi Kumar** is hereby **disposed of** with a direction to the petitioner to surrender before learned Trial Court and seek regular which shall be decided by learned Trial Court without being prejudiced by this order.
