

Counsel of Petitioner plaintiff moved his petition dated 21.03.2020 under Order 22 Rule 4 of the Code of Civil Procedure wherein it has been pleaded that defendant no. 2 Nagendra Chaubey of the suit has been died before seven-eight month. Details of legal heirs has been provided in the petition. Prayed for substitution of their name in place of respective deceased defendant.</p> <p>Petition in respect of condonation of delay has also been moved by the plaintiff and submitted that they were not having information about the death and no deliberate delay on their part in filing the petition. Prayed for condonation of delay.</p> <p>Perused the records. Reply has been filed by Defendant wherein fact of death has been admitted and specified that death occurred on 10.07.2017. No objection on name of legal heirs. It is noted that petition is duly supported by affidavit. There is no need to wait for the reply of defendants. The petition seems appropriate and proper.</p> <p>In view of the above, the petitions are allowed. Delay condoned on the cost of Rs. 500/- to be paid to defendant and substituted petition allowed on the cost of Rs. 500/- to be paid to defendant. Plaintiff is directed to get substituted name of legal heirs of deceased defendant as specified in the petition under reference.
