

Counsel of petitioner moved his petition dated 06.12.2025 under Order 1 Rule 10 & Order 22 Rule 3 of the Code of Civil Procedure wherein it has been pleaded that plaintiff No. 1 Lakshaman Bari of the suit has been died on 23.12.2019. Details of legal heirs has been provided in the petition.</p> <p>Petition in respect of condonation of delay has also been moved by the petitioner and submitted that they were not having information about the death and no deliberate delay on their part in filing the petition. Prayed for condonation of delay.</p> <p>Perused the records. Suit proceeding is <i>ex-parte</i> against all defendants. It is noted that petition is duly supported by affidavit. There is no need to wait for the reply of defendants. The petition seems appropriate and proper.</p> <p>In view of the above, the petition is allowed. Delay condoned on the cost of Rs. 250/- to be paid to Nazarat and petition is allowed on cost of Rs. 250/- to be paid to defendant contesting this petition.
