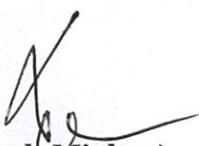

<u>04.11.2025</u>	Case called upon. Ld. Counsel of petitioner moved his petition dated 19.09.2025 under Order 22 Rule 3 read with Section 151 of the Code of Civil Procedure wherein it has been pleaded that plaintiff no. 4 Brijlal Singh of the suit has been died on 19.06.2023, plaintiff no. 16 Ramcheez Singh of the suit has been died on 28.10.2019, plaintiff no. 17 Srinath Singh of the suit has been died on 15.01.2018, plaintiff no. 18 Pati Nath Singh of the suit has been died (the date of death of plaintiff no. 18 is not specified) & plaintiff no. 19 Hira Singh of the suit has been died on 20.07.2020. Details of legal heirs have been provided in the petition. It is stated that legal heirs of plaintiff no. 6 Kalika Singh were substituted in the suit. His wife Rajkumari Kunwar was one of them. She has also been died. Other legal heirs are on record. Prayer for deletion of her name. Petition in respect of condonation of delay has also been moved by the petitioner and submitted that they were not having information about the death and no deliberate delay on their part in filing the petition. Prayed for condonation of delay. Perused the records. Suit proceeding is against all defendants. It is noted that petition is duly supported by affidavit. There is no need to wait for the reply of defendants. The petition seems appropriate and proper. In view of the above, the petition is allowed. Delay condoned on the cost of Rs. 2000/- to be paid to Nazarat and petition is allowed on cost of Rs. 2000/- to be paid to Nazarat. Office is directed to get name of legal heirs of	

deceased plaintiff, as specified in the petitions under reference, be substituted in the plaint.
