


**IN THE COURT OF CIVIL JUDGE (Jr. Div.), DUMRAON**

<u>15.01.2026</u>	<p>This case is listed today for order on petition dated 05.04.2025 of judgment debtors Satyendra Pathak under Section 151 CPC. In the petition, the judgment debtors have prayed that process of execution was done wrongfully, on paper only and not in reality by Nazir, Buxar. Formal objection were filed on 18.01.2025.</p> <p>In reply dated 19.04.2025, decree holder has <i>inter-alia</i> submitted that petition is not maintainable and filed to linger the execution. Nazir, Buxar has completed execution process following due procedure established in that regard. There is no provision for witness of Nazir. Lastly, prayer has been made for dismissal with heavy cost.</p> <p>Heard the parties and perused the records. On perusal of order sheet, it is noted that execution has been filed in 2003 for decree passed in Title Suit - 95/1982. On 03.04.2023 requisition has been issued to Nazir, Buxar for execution. Report has been received from Nazir, Buxar on 17.08.2024 that order for execution is not clear and on said date Office was directed to re-issue format with clear direction. Format for execution was issued to Nazir, Buxar, in terms of order dated 17.08.2024. Nazir, Buxar has submitted execution report on 02.11.2024 which is received on 16.11.2024.</p> <p>It is noted that it has also not specified what specific procedural fault has been committed by Nazir, Buxar and in what way petitioners were prejudiced.</p> <p>In view of the above, this Court is of the view that petition is devoid of any merit and liable to be dismissed.</p> <p>List on 16-02-2026 for hearing and order on petition dated 19.04.2025 of decree holder.</p> <p style="text-align: right;"> <b>(Prateek Mishra)</b> <b>Civil Judge (Jr. Div.), Dumraon</b></p>
