A petition has also been filed on behalf of the plaintiffs to sign upon the exhibited document submitted by them and both parties have also filed a petition to close their evidence and final order may be passed. Heard and perused;</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><u>ORDER</u></p> <p>Case record has been placed before me for final order on the point of compromise between the parties. It has been prayed on behalf of both the parties that plaintiffs and defendants of the suit have compromised this case and settled their dispute out of the court. A joint compromise petition dated 13.05.2026 has been filed and duly signed by both the parties and their respective counsels. The Ld. Counsels prayed to dispose of this case in view of the compromise taken place between the parties.</p> <p>Heard, the submissions put forward at bar and perused the case record. On perusal of the record it transpires that the suit has been filed by plaintiffs Anil Kumar & Ors. against defendants Umesh Singh & Ors. for declaration that to declare their possession & own properties as described in the schedule I, II, & III of the plaint. The defendants Umesh Singh & Ors. appeared in the suit and a joint compromise petition has been filed by both the parties, praying therein that the compromise has taken place between the parties, according to the terms and conditions as mentioned in the compromise petition. A report was called for of the Sheristedar, who has reported that the compromise petition has been duly signed by both the parties and their respective counsel and the same is in order. Further, in the course of proceedings, the statement on behalf of the Plaintiffs namely Anil Kumar(P.W.1), Bir Bahadur Singh(P.W.2) & Pramod Kumar Singh(P.W.3) and on behalf of the defendants Umesh Singh (D.W.1) & Hakim Singh(D.W.2), have been recorded and both parties have prayed to close their evidences & also exhibit the filed documents. Plaintiffs have also prayed to sign over the exhibited documents. Filed documents has been exhibited & signed over it. Defendants of this case has supported the factum of compromise. The parties of the suit has supported the factum of compromise in the court, in their statements on affidavit and corroborated the same in their respective cross-examination too.</p> <p>Hence, in the facts and circumstances of the case, considering all the materials available on the record, the argument put forward by the Ld. Counsels of both the parties; the fact that the compromise has taken place between the parties and in the interest of justice, this suit is hereby disposed of on the basis of compromise.
