10.03.2026	<p>Case called upon. Ld. Counsel of plaintiff has moved his even dated petition under Order 6 Rule 17 of CPC. It is stated that due to clerical mistake in schedule 01 of the plaint, Pandey has been written instead of Yadav and in schedule 02 name of plaintiff itself is omitted. Prayer has been made to allow the same considering clerical error in nature.</p> <p>Perused the records and heard the parties. It is noted that proceedings are <i>ex-parte</i> in the suit. Further, on perusal of record, it is noted that this amendment is filed with extreme delay without sufficient reasons of delay. However, error is clerical in nature and not affecting the nature of suit rather helpful in determination of issues before the Court.</p> <p>In view of the above discourse, this Court finds that the petition is maintainable, hence allowed without contest at the cost of Rs. 500/-.
