Whereas envelop of notice is there in record wherein endorsement of Dak Department is there suggesting that noticee is not residing at the address concerned.</p> <p>This court is of the view that this anomaly will affect the nature of the suit and necessary steps needs to be taken to rectify this defect.</p> <p>In view of the above, plaintiff is directed to take suitable steps for paper publication against defendant no. 2 in the newspaper having good circulation in the area of residence of said defendant.
