<u>21.04.2026</u>	<p>Case called upon. Ld. Counsel of both parties appeared and heard on petition dated 04.11.2025 of defendants no. 1 & 2 filed under Order 12 Rule 6 of CPC.</p> <p>On perusal of petition, it is noted that both defendants have admitted the case of plaintiff and submitted that relief has been sought against defendant no. 1 & 2. Land under dispute has been received by way of partition to Late Vindhyachal Singh (adoptive father of plaintiff) and defendant no. 1 & 2. Being adopted son of late Vindhyachal Singh, plaintiff is entitled to inherit property of said Vindhyachal Singh. Defendant first set do accept half share of plaintiff in land under dispute. They have mutually partitioned land under dispute. Property mentioned in schedule 1 of the petition will be of plaintiff and defendant no. 1 & 2 will get property mentioned in schedule 2 of petition. They are having no objection on claim of plaintiff rather they admitted the case of plaintiff. They prayed for judgment and decree in the light of the petition under consideration.</p> <p>Ld. Counsel of plaintiff has orally submitted no objection on the petition.</p> <p>Heard the parties and perused the records. It is noted that suit has been filed initially against 10 defendants. Later, plaintiff has withdrawn his suit against defendant no. 3 to 10 on ground that no relief has been made against them. Vide this petition, defendant has admitted claim of plaintiff and provided schedule of partition between them. It is stated that they have already partitioned the land under dispute as per schedule provided in the petition. Plaintiff has no objection on the petition as submitted by his counsel in the open Court.</p>	

As defendant has admitted the case of plaintiff and partition of land under dispute has already been taken place between parties to the suit. This Court finds no objection in confirming partition between the parties.

Hence, this suit is decreed and partition of land under dispute between plaintiff Shivam Singh and defendant no. 1 Gupteswar Singh @ Tengri Singh s/o Late Bagwadha Singh & defendant no. 2 Pintu Singh s/o Gupteswar Singh as per schedule attached with petition under consideration is hereby confirmed.

Suitable decree in terms of aforementioned order be passed. Schedule attached with petition dated 04.11.2025 of defendant 1 & 2 shall be part of the decree. Office is directed to consign the record in Record Room as per rule.
