ORAL ORDER

1. Perused application, say filed by prosecution and documents on record. Heard Advocate Sumaiya Qureshi for accused and Ld. A.P.P. Shri Rajput for prosecution.

2. It is alleged by state that the complainant is attached to D.B. Marg police station. On 13.06.2025, the complainant resumed night duty at 20.00 hours. On that night the complainant and other police were patrolling within the limits of police station. On 14.06.2025 at 3.30 hours, on Patthe Bapurao Marg, Grant Road, Mumbai the police had found accused No.1 Jitendra Mrutunjay Sarkar and No.2 Shanawaz Mohd. Jahid Ansari (applicant) in a car bearing No.MH-01-PA-0208. Both the accused were in suspicious condition. The accused Nos. 1 and 2 were apprehended. Their physical search and search of their car was conducted by following proper procedure under NDPS Act. In said search it was found that the accused No.1 was possessing 11.22 grams MD. The accused No.2 was possessing 2.30 grams MD. The police also found 3.91 grams MD in the car. Thus, accused nos. 1 and 2 were found possessing total 16.05 grams of MD. Accused Nos.1 and 2 were apprehended. On further inquiry the accused No.1 disclosed that he had purchased said MD powder from the accused Moin Majibul Ansari. After registration of FIR, C.R.No.486/2025 came to be registered for offence punishable under Section 8(c), 22(b) and 29 of NDPS Act. Accused Nos. 1 and 2 came to be arrested on 14.06.2025. The accused No.3 came to be arrested on 17.07.2025 by obtaining his custody from Crime No.506/2025 registered with D.B. Marg Police Station. The involvement of more persons namely Anas, Asif and Vikas has been revealed. They are to be arrested. If applicant/accused is released on bail, he is likely to

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abscond and help the absconding accused. The applicant/accused is having criminal antecedents. The procedure for action under Section 111 of BNS is to be undertaken. The applicant/accused is not having permanent address in Mumbai. He is likely to abscond. Hence, application be rejected.

3. APP Shri Rajput argued in the line of say and objected the application. He submitted that applicant/accused is involved in more crimes. The procedure for action under Section 111 of BNS is being followed. Hence, application be rejected.

4. The quantity of seized Mephedrone is 16.05 grams. It is intermediate quantity. Thus, rigor of Section 37 is not strictly applicable in the present case. As submitted by Advocate Sumaiya Qureshi the investigation has been completed and charge-sheet is already filed. Nothing has remained to be investigated. Considering all these facts, the further custody of applicant/accused is not at all warranted.

Hence, the order:

ORDER

1. NDPS Bail Application No.673 of 2025 is hereby allowed.
2. The applicant/accused **Ansari Shahnawaz Mohammed Zahid** in connection with Crime bearing No.486/2025 registered with D.B. Marg Police Station, Mumbai be released on bail on executing PR Bond of Rs.30,000/- (Rupees Thirty Thousands Only) and surety in like amount on following conditions:
 - (i) he shall attend the Court regularly.
 - (ii) he shall not tamper with the evidence or interfere in ongoing investigation or trial.

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(iii) he shall not leave limits of India without prior permission of this Court.

(iv) Any deliberate breach of above conditions shall result in cancellation or revocation of bail order.

3. NDPS Bail Application No.673 of 2025 stands disposed of accordingly.
