	08.04.2026	Attendance has been filed on behalf of both the parties. A petition has also been filed on behalf of the plaintiff to sign upon the exhibited document submitted by him and both parties have also filed a petition to close their evidence and final order may be passed. Heard and perused; <u>ORDER</u> Case record has been placed before me for final order on the point of compromise between the parties. It has been prayed on behalf of both the parties that plaintiff and defendant of the suit have compromised this case and settled their dispute out of the court. A joint compromise petition dated 10.09.2025 has been filed and duly signed by both the parties and their respective counsels. The Ld. Counsels prayed to dispose of this case in view of the compromise taken place between the parties. Heard, the submissions put forward at bar and perused the case record. On perusal of the record it transpires that the suit has been filed by plaintiff Krishna Kanhaiya Tiwari against defendants Mithilesh Tiwari for declaration that to partition the ancestral properties as described in the schedule I of the plaint. The defendant Mithilesh Tiwari appeared in the suit and a joint compromise petition has been filed by both the parties, praying therein that the compromise has taken place between the parties, according to the terms and conditions as mentioned in the compromise petition. A report was called for of the Sheristedar, who has reported that the compromise petition has been duly signed by both the parties and their respective counsel and the same is in order. Further, in the course of proceedings, the statement on behalf of the Plaintiff namely Krishna Kanhaiya Tiwari and on behalf of the defendant Mithilesh Tiwari (D.W.1), have been recorded and both parties have prayed to close their evidences & also exhibit the filed documents. The plaintiff has also prayed to sign over the exhibited documents. Filed documents has been exhibited & signed over it. The Defendant of this case has supported the factum of compromise. The parties of the suit has supported the factum of compromise in the court, in their statements on affidavit and corroborated the same in their respective cross-examination too. Hence, in the facts and circumstances of the case, considering all the materials available on the record, the argument put forward by the Ld. Counsels of both the parties; the fact that the compromise has taken place between the parties and in the interest of justice, this suit is hereby disposed of on the basis of compromise. The joint compromise petition dated 20.09.2025 filed by both the parties shall form part of the compromise decree.
