ORDER

1. The present application has been filed on behalf of the petitioners seeking regular bail in connection with Sakatpur P.S. Case No. 021 of 2025, dated 04.03.2025, registered under Sections 126(2), 115(2), 118(1), 109, 352, 351(2), 3(5) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, which is presently pending in the Court of the learned Shri Ratnesh Manjhi JMFC, Darbhanga. The petitioners are in judicial custody since 07.01.2026.
2. As per the FIR, the prosecution case, in brief, is that on 03.03.2025 at about 01:30 P.M., the accused persons namely Mahesh Singh, Nitish Kumar, Anand Kumar, Dhiraj Kumar, Shambhu Kumar, Asharfi Sadai, Arjun Kumar, Sangeet Sadai, Birju Sadai, Bijual Sadai and Raju Sadai, allegedly armed with various weapons such as bhala, garansa, khanti, knife, pachariya and spade, came to the pond of the informant and started fishing. It is further alleged that when the informant protested, the accused persons came to the courtyard of the informant and began abusing and

3. It is further alleged that when the nephew of the informant, namely Amit Kumar, came to rescue him, accused Sangeet Kumar and Mahesh Singh assaulted him with dagger and farsa, causing injuries to him. It is also alleged that accused Arjun Sadai and Sangeet Sadai assaulted him with knife and farsa, while the other accused persons assaulted him with lathi, danda, khanti, pachariya, spade and bhala.
4. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners are innocent and have been falsely implicated in the present case due to previous enmity, grudge and local politics. It is further submitted that the allegations made against the petitioners are false and baseless. It is also submitted that the petitioners have been implicated in order to save the informant's side from Sakatpur P.S. Case No. 34 of 2022.
5. It is further submitted that petitioner nos. 2 and 3 have clean antecedents, whereas petitioner no. 1 has two criminal antecedents. It is also argued that the pond in question is a Government pond and does not belong to the informant, and that the dispute arose when the animals of the petitioners entered the pond for drinking water. It is further submitted that some of the co-accused persons have already been granted regular bail.
6. Learned Public Prosecutor has opposed the prayer for bail.
7. From the materials available on record, it appears that specific allegations have been made against petitioner Mahesh Singh and Sangeet Kumar of assaulting Amit Kumar with knife and farsa. A perusal of the

injury report of Amit Kumar Chaudhary shows that he sustained injuries on his person, though the injuries have been reported to be simple in nature. It further appears that no specific overt act has been attributed to petitioner Arjun Sadai @ Arjun Kumar. It also appears that investigation in the case has been completed and charge-sheet has already been submitted.

8. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, the nature of allegations, the period of custody undergone by the petitioners, and the fact that investigation has already been completed, I am inclined to allow the prayer for bail. Accordingly, the petitioners above named are directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) each with two sureties of the like amount, to the satisfaction of the learned Court concerned, subject to usual conditions.
