ORDER

The petitioner above named seeks pre-arrest bail in connection with Sadar P.S Case No.-293/2025, U/s- 126(2), 115(2), 132, 351(2), 352, BNS.

It is submitted that the petitioner is innocent and has committed no offence. It is further submitted that the petitioner has clean antecedents and have been falsely implicated in this case. No application for bail on behalf of the petitioner has been preferred either in this learned Court or before the Hon'ble High Court of Judicature at Patna earlier in this case and no such petition is pending anywhere in any form. Earlier the petitioner was made an accused in Sadar P.S Case No.562/2015 under Sections 341, 323, 448, 379, 504, 506, 34 IPC in which he is on bail.

The Learned Public Prosecutor vehemently opposed the prayer for bail.

As per FIR, as per direction of Anchal Office, Sadar, Darbhanga, when the informant Avinash Kumar an Anchal Amin reached for measurement of a land on 12.09.2025, he found the same water logged containing Jal Kumbhi and he wanted to return after taking GPS photo of the same but the petitioner present there asked the informant that he had earlier got measured the said land and on the basis of the same, he could measure the land and then abused and assaulted him and threatened to kill them, if he would return without measuring the land. Earlier also on 03.09.2025, he abused the

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informant by using the mobile of office staff Rajkishore Thakur and threatened to kill him. It is alleged that by that way, he obstructed him in discharge of his official duty. On the basis of written report, the FIR was lodged u/s- 126(2), 115(2), 132, 351(2), 352, BNS.

Perused the case diary. It transpires that the prosecution version finds support from it. It further transpires that he was not arrested by the police during investigation and he was released under Section 35(6) of BNSS on the bond. The charge-sheet has already been submitted against the petitioner under Section 126(2), 115(2), 132, 351(2), 352, BNS and as such, no fruitful purpose would be served by denying him anticipatory bail and sending him jail.

Having considered aforesaid including clean antecedents of the petitioner, let, the petitioner be **released** on bail in the event of his arrest or surrender within four weeks from today, before the learned Court concerned, on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of the said Court, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 482 (2) BNSS.
