ORDER

1. The petitioners above named seeks pre-arrest bail in connection with Baheri PS Case No.-46/2026, Dated-21.01.2026, U/s- 126(2), 115(2), 109(1), 118(1), 74, 303(2), 351(2), 352, 3(5) BNS.
2. It is submitted that the petitioners are innocent and has committed no offence. It is further stated that the petitioners have clean antecedents and has been falsely implicated in this case. No bail application has been filed earlier or pending in any form on behalf of the petitioner either before this court or before any superior court. The petitioners have no criminal antecedents from before.
3. The Learned Public Prosecutor vehemently opposed the prayer for bail.
4. As per FIR on 20.01.2026 when the informant Harendra Narayan Jha @ Pappu was going to purchase some articles near Brahmsthan, the petitioner and other co-accused armed with lathi, iron rod, etc, surrounded and abused him and on instigation of petitioner No.1 Ram Pabitra Yadav and petitioner No.2 Satya Narayan Yadav assaulted on the head of the informant by rod and he sustained head injury. When his son, wife and daughter came forward in his rescue, he misbehaved and assaulted them also. The petitioner snatched gold Hanumani from the informant. The informant was taken to DMCH for the treatment

and on the basis of which written report was lodged under section 126(2), 115(2), 109(1), 118(1), 74, 303(2), 351(2), 352, 3(5) BNS.

5. Perused the case diary. There is specific allegation against the petitioner Ram Pabitra Yadav that he instigated other co-accused and then the petitioner Satya Narayan Yadav assaulted on the head of the informant by a rod and he sustained head injury. The injury report of the informant shows few small hemorrhagic contusions in right temporo-parietal lobe. Linear fracture right temporo-parietal bone with mild overlying scalp swelling. Mild blood density noted in cortical sulci in left high frontal region. Small subdural hematoma (max. thickness 4mm) noted over right franto-parietal convexity. Thus said injury appears to be grievous and on vital part of the body. Further, the report also shows the fracture of digital and terminal feelings of middle finger and the nature of injuries has been shown as grievous caused by hard and blunt object. The investigation of the case is still going on.
6. Having considering aforesaid including the nature of injury caused to the injured and present stage of investigation, this court is of the view that the petitioners do not deserve the privilege of anticipatory bail. Accordingly, the prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioners namely Ram Pabitra Yadav and Satya Narayan Yadav is hereby rejected.
