**ORDER.**

**04. 10.03.2026** Heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned P.P. for the State on anticipatory bail filed on behalf of above named petitioner, who is apprehending his arrest in connection with Mahila P.S. Case No. 174/25 for offences U/Ss 85, 115(2), 303(2), 351(2), 352 and 3(5) of the B.N.S.

As per FIR, prosecution case in short is that the marriage of the informant was solemnized with accused petitioner namely Md. Nurahasnan on 05.05.2009 as per Islamic rites and customs. After marriage, informant went to her matrimonial house with some gifted items of gold, clothes, furniture and utensils. It is further alleged that informant got three daughters out of her wedlock. It is further alleged that when the informant gave birth to the second daughter then accused petitioner and his family members started demanding of Rs. 2,00,000/- cash as a dowry and upon non fulfillment of the same they abused, assaulted and tortured her physically and mentally. It is further alleged that accused petitioner also stopped giving food to eat to the informant. It is further alleged that when the informant gave birth to the third daughter then accused persons again started demanding of money and also tried to kill the informant by pouring kerosene oil. It is further alleged that on 19.12.2024 accused petitioner and his family members took her all belongings and lastly

ousted her from matrimonial house with her three daughters.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is innocent and has committed no offence. It is further submitted that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case. He further submitted that no occurrence took place as alleged by the informant. He further submitted that petitioner has no manner of concern with the alleged occurrence as alleged in the FIR. He further submitted that the first marriage of the informant was solemnized with Md. Chand and after divorce she solemnized second marriage with the petitioner. He further submitted that the informant was always putting pressure upon the petitioner for transfer the property in her name and on refusal she went away with Md. Chand on 19.12.2024 and remarry with him. He further submitted that accused petitioner is ready to keep his wife with full honour and dignity. He further submitted that no case is made out against the petitioner u/s 498A of the IPC & Section 4 of the Dowry Prohibition Act. He further submitted that the accused petitioner has no criminal antecedent. It is therefore, prayed to enlarge the petitioner on anticipatory bail.

On the other hand, learned P. P. opposed the prayer for bail of the petitioner.

From the perusal of FIR as well as case diary, it is alleged against accused petitioner that he along with other his family members demanded dowry from the informant and on non fulfillment of the same they abused, assaulted and tortured to the informant. It appears that marriage of accused petitioner was solemnized with informant of this case in the year 2009.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case discussed

above, this court is inclined to enlarge the petitioner on anticipatory bail. It is therefore ordered that in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned lower court within a fortnight from the date of receipt of copy of this order, the petitioners will be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (rupees ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to satisfaction of the learned lower court, subject to the conditions laid down under section 482(2) of the BNSS with condition that he will cooperate in the investigation/trial of this case.
