ORDER

1. The petitioners above named seek pre-arrest bail in connection with Baheri PS Case No.-57/2026, Dated-30.01.2026 U/ss 189(2), 126(2), 115(2), 118(1), 110 of BNS is pending in the court of Learned ACJM-VII, Darbhanga.
2. The case of the prosecution in brief is that on 26.01.2026 a Panchayati was held between informants younger brother Navin Lal Dev and petitioner No. 1 & 10 in which after settlement it is alleged that petitioners started to assault on which said Navin Lal Dev fled away but the informant could not flee on which it is alleged that all the petitioners assaulted him and further it is alleged that petitioner No. 2 assaulted him with sickle causing injury in his finger.
3. It is submitted by the counsel for the petitioner that the petitioners are innocent and have committed no offence. It is further stated that the petitioners have clean antecedent. It is submitted that the informants brother namely Navin Lal Dev made naked video of petitioner No. 9 at the time when she was bathing and sent the video on mobile of

petitioner no. 9 for which a Panchayati was held during which the informant along with others committed offence with petitioner No. 9 and others for which petitioner No. 9 got registered Baheri P.S. case No. 48/26 against informant and others and as such the instant case has been filed as counter version of Baheri P.S. Case No. 48/26.

4. The Learned Public Prosecutor opposes the bail petition.
5. Heard both parties, peruse the case record including the case diary. The injury report is not attached with the case diary. The petitioner's side has already filed a case against the informant side prior to filing of this case alleging therein that the brother of the informant of this case was prepared in obscene video to the Kamini Devi and for that a Panchayat was held and later on this case has been filed. There is general and omnibus allegation of accused. Considering the facts and circumstances of the prior case to the petitioner that the petitioners anticipatory bail is here by allowed. Let the petitioners namely Dilip Mukhiya, Jagdish Mukhiya, Chandrakala Devi, Rama Shish Mukhiya, Chandrakala Devi, Vishal Mukhiya, Bholu Mukhiya, @ Kalesh Kumar, Purnima Devi @ Purniya Devi, Kamini Devi, Sanjay Mukhiya are directed to furnish a bail bond of Rs. 5,000/- with two sureties of like amount with an undertaking under Section 482 of BNSS and condition that they will not commit the offence of similar nature in future, subject to the satisfaction of learned Court concerned in the event of their arrest or surrender by the petitioner within 15 days of the receipt/production of the order.
