ORDER

03. 09.03.2026 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned P.P. for the state on the bail petition filed on behalf of above named accused/petitioner, who is in custody since 08.11.2025 in connection with Sonki P.S. Case No. 149/2025 offence U/s 303(2) and 317(2) of the BNS.

As per FIR, the prosecution case in short is that on 08.11.2025 at about 03 AM when the informant was at home and manage his cattle and farming business. It is further alleged that informant had tied the buffalo near the pond Tikkapatti. It is further alleged that when the informant woke up at 03 AM and gone to the pond Tikapatti and found that his buffalo was missing and rope was also not there. It is further alleged that when the informant searched, then he came to know that his own villager namely Dhaneshwar Sada had gone towards village Ghusi Ramnagar to sell the buffalo. On this information, informant went towards that side with villagers and then on the way Dhaneshwar Sada was caught with informant's buffalo.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is quite innocent and has committed no offence. It has further submitted that petitioner has been implicated in this case due to grudge, enmity and village politics. He further submitted that nothing incriminating has been recovered from the conscious possession of accused petitioner and he has not arrested on the spot. He further submitted that the investigation of this case is completed. The accused petitioner is in jail custody since 08.11.2025. It is therefore, prayed to enlarge the petitioner on bail.

On the other hand, learned P. P. opposed the prayer for bail of the petitioner.

From perusal of FIR, it is alleged against accused petitioner had stolen the buffalo of the informant and tried to sale it. The investigation of the case is completed and charge sheet has been submitted in this case. The accused petitioner is in jail custody since 08.11.2025 i.e. about four months.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case discussed above as well as the period of custody already undergone, instant bail petition filed on behalf of petitioner is hereby **allowed** on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned trial court with condition that he will not to commit such occurrence in future and also cooperate in the trial of this case.
