**ORDER**

**03. 09.03.2026** Heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned P.P. for the state on the bail petition filed on behalf of above named accused/petitioner, who is in custody since 21.07.2025 in connection with Keoti P.S. Case No. 186/2025 offence U/s 303(2) and 317(2) of the BNS.

As per FIR, the prosecution case in short is that on 21.07.2025 at about 11 AM informant's maternal uncle namely Md. Badre Alam, whose house is situated in front of the Panchayat Bhawan in Chatwan villager was locked. It is alleged that an unknown person entered the house of the informant through the roof and broke the lock of the lower two rooms and started stealing the items kept in the house and slowly started taking the items out through the back road of the house. It is further alleged that local people saw him doing this, so they became suspicious and started questioning him, but he was not telling anything properly. It is further alleged that the local people entered into the house, they saw that the locks of two rooms and the main door were broken, so they informed the police at that time and until the police arrived, the local people also beat up the thief. It is further alleged that the Keoti police arrived at the spot and took the accused persons to the Keoti police station along with the items, where during questioning the unknown person told his name as Sudhir Sahni.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is quite innocent and has committed no offence. It has further submitted that petitioner has been implicated in this case. He further submitted that accused petitioner is not named in the FIR and nothing incriminating has been recovered from the conscious possession of accused petitioner and he has not arrested on the spot. He further submitted that the investigation of this case is

completed. He further submitted that the accused petitioner has no any criminal antecedent. The accused petitioner is in jail custody since 21.07.2025. It is therefore, prayed to enlarge the petitioner on bail.

On the other hand, learned P. P. opposed the prayer for bail of the petitioner.

From perusal of FIR, it is alleged against accused petitioner had committed theft to the house of the informant's maternal uncle, who lives in Mumbai. The investigation of the case is completed and charge sheet has been submitted in this case. He further submitted that the accused petitioner has no any criminal antecedent. The accused petitioner is in jail custody since 21.07.2025 i.e. more than seven months.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case discussed above as well as the period of custody already undergone, instant bail petition filed on behalf of petitioner is hereby **allowed** on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned trial court with condition that he will not to commit such occurrence in future and also cooperate in the trial of this case.
