**ORDER**

1. The petitioner is praying for provisional bail in connection with Town PS Case No.- 125 of 2025, Dated- 07.07.2025, U/s- 115(2), 126(2), 303(2), 117(2), 109, 76, 324(1), 351(2), 352, 3(5) of the BNS is pending in the Court of Ld CJM, Darbhanga. The petitioner is in judicial custody since 18.02.2026.
2. A petition has been filed on behalf of the petitioner stating that Khushbu Kumari, the daughter of the petitioner, is going to be married on 13.03.2026. A copy of the marriage card has been annexed with the petition in support of the said submission. It has been further submitted that the Puja and Matkor ceremonies have already commenced from 09.03.2026, and the petitioner, being the father and natural guardian of the bride, is required to perform the Kanyadaan and other essential rituals during the marriage ceremony.
3. It has also been submitted that the case diary in Bail Petition No. 226 of 2026 has not yet been received by this Court. Therefore, considering the urgency of the situation and the impending marriage of the petitioner's daughter, it has been prayed that the petitioner be granted provisional bail for a limited period from 12.03.2026 to 15.03.2026 in order to enable him to attend and perform the necessary marriage rituals.
4. The learned Public Prosecutor appearing on behalf of the State has not raised any objection to the prayer for grant of temporary bail for the

limited period as prayed for.

5. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, the urgency involved, and the fact that the marriage of the petitioner's daughter is scheduled shortly, the prayer appears to be reasonable.
6. Accordingly, the petitioner Mohan Ray is allowed to be released on provisional bail from 12.03.2026 to 15.03.2026 on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties of the like amount each, subject to the condition that one of the bailors shall be a close family member of the petitioner.
7. The petitioner is further directed to surrender before the concerned court on 16.03.2026 without fail.
