ORDER

1. The petitioner is praying for regular bail in connection with Arising out of Town PS Case No.- 125 of 2025, Dated- 07.07.2025, U/s- 115(2), 126(2), 303(2), 117(2), 109, 76, 324(1), 351(2), 352, 3(5) of the BNS is pending in the Court of Ld CJM, Darbhanga. The petitioner is in judicial custody since 18.02.2026.
2. The case of the prosecution in brief is that the present petitioner along with nine other accused persons forcibly entered into the premises of Radha Krishan Baldev Mandir on 05.07.2025 at about 2:15 PM. It is further stated that the accused persons had deadly weapons in their hands and they brutally assaulted the priests of the aforesaid temple. The accused persons also looted Rs 43,000/- cash and damaged the goods worth Rs. 60,000/-.
3. It is submitted by the counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner is innocent and has committed no offence. It is further stated that the petitioner has four more cases pending against him. It is further stated that there is no specific allegation against this petitioner in the entire FIR and he is rotting in jail since 18.02.2026.
4. The Learned Public Prosecutor opposed the bail petition.
5. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and also keeping in mind that there is no specific allegation against this petitioner and also the period of custody already undergone, let this petitioner be **allowed** on bail on furnishing of bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two

sureties of like amount to the satisfaction of learned Court concerned with a condition that the petitioner shall not indulge in similar nature of cases again.
