ORDER

1. The petitioner is praying for regular bail in connection with Bahadurpur PS Case No.- 45 of 2026, Dated- 24.02.2026, U/s- 87, 137(2) of the BNS is pending in the court of Ld ACJM-IX, Darbhanga. The petitioner is in judicial custody since 25.02.2026.
2. The case of the prosecution in brief is that the minor daughter of the informant went out of her house at 7 pm on 23.02.2026 to answer the call of nature but did not returned back. The informant then went in search of her daughter and she has firm belief that her minor daughter was taken away by the petitioner Suraj Kumar.
3. It is submitted by the counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner is innocent and has committed no offence. It is further stated that petitioner has clean. The present case is filed by the informant due to dirty village politics, hence, bail may be granted.
4. The Learned Public Prosecutor opposes the bail petition and has submitted that the witnesses have supported the case of the prosecution and the victim has given her statement before the court in which she has stated that after talking with the present petitioner she went out of her house and then Suraj came there and took her to some other place where they both live for one day and then they were caught by the police. It is further submitted that the date of birth of the victim is 01.01.20210 and the victim was minor at the time of occurrence.
5. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and also keeping in

mind that the victim was minor at the time of the occurrence, hence, even the consent was given it is of no use and the victim has clearly stated that the petitioner took him to his friend's house where they live together for one day, I am not inclined to grant bail to this petitioner and accordingly, this bail petition stands **rejected**.
