It is submitted that the petitioner intend to withdraw this case. Therefore, she has filed withdrawal application dated 02.06.2026 which is already available on record.

In the light of the aforesaid facts, statement of the petitioner recorded on SA. It is stated that the petitioner filed the present miscellaneous case for restoration of Maintenance Case No. 145/2017. However, the parties have amicably settled their dispute, their marriage has been dissolved by mutual consent, and the petitioner has received a lump-sum amount towards permanent alimony and maintenance (past, present and future) and now, she does not wish to pursue this case further. It is also stated that she has taken this decision in her full sense, without any fear or pressure. She stated that if this case is disposed of, she has no objection.

Heard and perused the case record, it appears that all dispute including right of maintenance (past, present and future) and permanent alimony already settled between the petitioner and opposite party. Petitioner intends to withdraw this case hence, this is a fit case to be disposed of.

Accordingly, this Miscellaneous case is hereby dismissed as withdrawn on compromise as prayed.
