ORDER

18.04.2026

1. The petitioner above named sought regular bail in connection with Bahadurpur PS Case No 410 of 2025 registered for the offence under Sections 192(2), 191(3), 190, 126(2), 115(2), 117(2), 109, 352, 103(1) of the Bhartiya Nyay Sanhita (hereinafter referred to as 'BNS' for short). The petitioner is in judicial custody since 09.03.2026.
2. The Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submitted that he was innocent and had not committed any offence. It was submitted that petitioner had not filed bail petition of any sort earlier this court or either before any superior court. It was also submitted that there is one criminal antecedent vide Bahadurpur PS Case No. 140/2025 had been pending before the learned Court of ACJM-IX. It was further submitted that a petition vide ABP No. 1489/2025 and Criminal Miscellaneous 7908/26 had been rejected by order of ADJ-1 and Judicature at Patna High Court. It was further stated that the petitioner had been implicated by the informant due to dirty village politics, personal grudge and old enemies. It was submitted that the petitioner was ready to abide by the condi-

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tion(s) imposed upon him by the learned court. The learned counsel prayed for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

3. The Learned Public Prosecutor opposed the petition and prayed to reject it.
4. Heard both the sides, perused the case record and the case diary.
5. The prosecution case according to FIR in brief is that the petitioner along with the other accused persons indiscriminately assaulted the informant's father with the iron rod, bamboo, bricks and sticks. One Rama hit informant's father head with brick which caused a fracture. It is alleged that all the accused persons assaulted informant's father till he was severely injured. When the informant intervened, he was also brutally assaulted by the accused persons. The informant's father went into coma and subsequently died in course of treatment.
6. The witnesses in their statement recorded in Section 180 of the BNSS (Para-4, 5, 25, 26, 36, 68) supported the prosecution case. Informant's father Surya Narayan Yadav died in course of treatment at DMCH. The post mortem report revealed that cause of death was hemorrhage and shock due to the injuries caused by hard and blunt substance.
7. Though the petitioner has been in custody since 09.03.2026 but taking into account the facts, circumstances and nature of allegation against the petitioner, I am not of the opinion to enlarge him on bail. In the result, the bail petition filed on behalf of the petitioner namely **Guru Paswan** stands **rejected**.
8. It is made clear that this order has no bearing on the merits of the case.

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9. Let a copy of this order be sent to the concerned jurisdictional court.
10. Let this case record be deposited in the Record Room, Civil Court, Darbhanga after all due diligence.
