ORDER

20.04.2026

1. The petitioner above named sought regular bail in connection with Ghanshyampur PS Case No 216 of 2025 registered for the offence under Sections 115(2), 126(2), 64, 352, 351(2) of the Bhartiya Nyay Sanhita (hereinafter referred to as 'BNS' for short). The petitioner is in judicial custody since 30.12.2025.
2. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submitted that he was innocent and had not committed any offence. It was also submitted that the petitioner has clean antecedent. Earlier ABP was filed on behalf of the petitioner was rejected by Ld. Court of ADJ, Biraul, thereafter no ABP has been filed before the Hon'ble High Court, Patna and no such petition is pending anywhere. The petitioner was arrested by the police and remanded to jail custody and a bail petition filed on behalf of the Ld. Lower Court was rejected on 05.01.2026. The petitioner is falsely implicated in this case due to dirty village politics, malice and personal grudge. There is much delay in lodging FIR i.e. 18 days without any explanation. It is further stated that the petitioner is an unemployed person and he works hard at a shop in his village. The informant filed a petition earlier in the concern court below on 10.12.2025 in which she denied the allegation levelled in the FIR against the petitioner.
3. Learned Public Prosecutor assisted by the learned counsel for the informant opposed the prayer of regular bail.
4. Heard both the sides, perused the case record and the case diary.

5. The allegation against the petitioner is that he committed rape with the prosecutrix and when she was going to file the FIR he threatened her.
6. The prosecutrix in her restatement u/s 180 of the BNSS and u/s 183 of the BNSS before the court supported the allegation against the petitioner. Charge sheet for offence u/s 64(1) of the BNS inter alia other offences has been submitted in this case.
7. Though the petitioner has been in custody since 30.12.2025 but taking into account the facts, circumstances, nature of allegation and stage of the case I am not of the opinion to enlarge him on bail. In the result, the bail petition filed on behalf of the petitioner namely **Bolbam Jha** stands **rejected**.
8. It is made clear that this order has no bearing on the merits of the case.
9. Let a copy of this order be sent to the concerned jurisdictional court.
10. Let this case record be deposited in the Record Room, Civil Court, Darbhanga after all due diligence.
