**ORDER**

1. The petitioner is praying for regular bail in connection with Baheri PS Case No.-46/2026, Dated-26.01.2026, U/s- 126(2), 115(2), 109(1), 118(1), 74, 303(2), 351(2), 352, 3(5) BNS. The petitioner is in judicial custody since 16.06.2026.
2. It is submitted by the counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner is innocent and has committed no offence and has been falsely implicated in this case. It is further submitted that the petitioner has clean antecedents. It is further submitted that earlier an anticipatory bail vide A.B.P. No. 240/26 was filed on behalf of the petitioner and others but on account of arrest of the petitioner his bail petition was withdrawn, save and except no other bail petition has been filed or pending in any form either before this court or before any superior court. The petitioner has no criminal antecedents from before. He further submitted that no case is made out under Section 109 BNS against the petitioner. The petitioner is in judicial custody since 16.03.2026, hence, prayed for bail.
3. The Learned Public Prosecutor vehemently opposed the prayer for bail.
4. As per FIR on 20.01.2026 when the informant Harendra Narayan Jha @ Pappu was going to purchase some articles near Brahmasthan, the petitioner and other co-accused armed with lathi, iron rod, etc, surrounded and abused him and on instigation of co-accused Ram

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Pabitra Yadav, co-accused Satya Narayan Yadav assaulted on the head of the informant by rod and he sustained head injury. When his son, wife and daughter came forward in his rescue, he misbehaved and assaulted them also. The petitioner snatched gold Hanumani from the informant. The informant was taken to DMCH for the treatment and on the basis of which written report was lodged under section 126(2), 115(2), 109(1), 118(1), 74, 303(2), 351(2), 352, 3(5) BNS.

5. Perused the case diary. It transpires that the prosecution was finds support from it. The allegation against the petitioner appears to be omnibus and general except the allegation of theft for which it is submitted that the same is ornamental. It is further submitted that the petitioner has no criminal antecedents and the Ld. APP also failed to produce any criminal antecedents of the petitioner inspite of sufficient opportunity provided therefor. The petitioner is in custody since 16.03.2026.
6. Having considered aforesaid including the period of custody of the petitioner and his clean antecedents. Let, the petitioner be released on bail on furnishing of bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- with two sureties of like amount to the satisfaction of learned Court concerned.
