ORDER

04.06.2026

1. The petitioner above named sought anticipatory bail in connection with Hayaghat P.S. Case No 14/2026 registered for the offences under Section 126(2), 115(2), 118(2), 109, 303(2), 352, 351(2), 3(5) of the Bhartiya Nyay Sanhita (hereinafter referred to as 'BNS' for short).
2. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submitted that he was innocent and had not committed any offence. It was further submitted that petitioner had not filed bail petition of any sort earlier this court or either before any superior court. It was also submitted that the petitioner has no previous criminal antecedent. It was also submitted that the petitioner is not named in the FIR. It was also submitted that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case only on the confessional statement of co-accused Md. Belal and the petitioner has no concern with the other co-accused. It was also alleged that there is no positive evidence against this petitioner, so no any offence is made out against this petitioner. The petitioner has no any concern with the alleged occurrence or the other co-accused so no offence is made out against this petitioner. It was submitted that the petitioner was ready to abide by the condition(s) imposed upon him by the learned court. The learned counsel prayed for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.
3. Learned Public Prosecutor opposed the petition and prayed to reject it.
4. Heard both the sides, perused the case record as well as the case record of ST 361/26.
5. The prosecution case according to FIR in brief is that informant's nephew Sachin was called by Irshad on phone for some urgent work near tempo stand. When Sachin reached there Irshad and other 10 to 15 boys surrounded him and Irshad indiscriminately assaulted Sachin with a dagger causing severe injuries on his head arm chest and back. Sachin golden chain cash also stolen.
6. Petitioner is not named in the FIR but his name surfaced in this case on the basis of confessional statement of the co-accused Md. Belal wherein he imputed the petitioner and have assaulted the informant's nephew with a dagger along with other

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accused persons. The injury report of the injured Sachin shows stabbed injuries over his right para spinal region of the back, depth inside the abdomen cavity going up to cortex region of right kidney, over left scapular region, left side of chest and left side of scalp and also severe right renal injury detected.

7. Though the petitioner has no criminal antecedent but taking into account the nature of allegation and severity of injuries, I do not find it a fit case to grant him the privilege of anticipatory bail. In the result, the anticipatory bail petition filed on behalf of the petitioner namely **Sunny Paswan @ Turanta Paswan** stands **rejected**.
8. It is made clear that this order has no bearing on the merits of the case.
9. Let a copy of this order be sent to the concerned Jurisdictional Court.
10. Let this case record be deposited in the Record Room, Civil Court, Darbhanga after all due diligence.
