**ORDER**

1. The petitioner is praying for regular bail in connection with Jalley PS Case No.-56/2026, Dated-13.03.2026, U/s- 309(4), 308(2), 352, 351(2) of BNS is pending in the Court of ACJM-I, Darbhanga. The petitioner is in judicial custody since 13.03.2026.
2. The case of the prosecution in brief as alleged by the informant Sanjeev Raj is that on 07.03.2026, brother of the informant namely Ankit Raj, alongwith his friends had gone to village- Radhi in two Scorpio vehicles to attend a wedding ceremony and they parked their vehicle near a pond and talking each other. At that moment Rakesh Yadav @ Bulla Yadav and Madan Yadav both resident of Radhi villlage in intoxicated condition alongwith five to seven persons started abusing them. Meanwhile, Rakesh Yadav and Madan Yadav forcibly snatched the vehicle keys from drivers and became ready to assault them. Further it has been stated by the informant that when the informant and others went to village Radhi to discuss the matter, Rakesh Yadav, Anil Sah, Sanjeev Sah, Madan Yadav, Lal Yadav and another 20 to 30 persons to take his vehicles, then Rakesh Yadav asked to pay extortion sum of Rs. 2 lakhs then only vehicles will be handed over.
3. It is submitted by the counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner is innocent and has committed no offence. It is further stated that the petitioner is clean antecedent. On 07.03.2026 informant's brother alongwith his friend came to village Radhi in two scorpio vehicles

to attend a wedding ceremony, drivers of said vehicles were driving the vehicles on the road in very rash and negligent manner to overtake each other and one the aforesaid vehicle dashed one Dipu Kumar who sustained severe injuries. Thereafter, the member of the community arrived to mediate the dispute and ensure the wedding ceremony on a assurance of the informant and others to bear the cost of medical treatment of the child who is admitted in the clinic of Dr. Ramashish Yadav's hospital Darbhanga. Later on the informant refuse to pay the treatment cost and lodged this false case against the petitioner and others.

4. The Learned Public Prosecutor opposes the bail petition.
5. Heard both the parties peruse the case record. There is case counter case between the parties and as per allegation it is alleged that petitioner along with other snatched the key of vehicle and demanded the ransom money whereas the petitioner ground there is accident and treatment of accused they have agree for the treatment and due to that there is dispute the accused arises the petitioner has no criminal antecedent.
6. Considering the facts and circumstances the period of custody since 13.03.2026, having no criminal antecedent and there is case and counter case between the parties as well as considering the totality of offence, Let this petitioner be **allowed** on bail on furnishing of bail bonds of Rs. 5,000/- with two sureties of like amount to the satisfaction of learned Court concerned.
