**ORDER**

**18.05.2026**

1. The petitioner above named sought regular bail in connection with Manigacchi PS Case No 180/2024 registered for the offence under Sections 96, 3(5) of the Bhartiya Nyay Sanhita (hereinafter referred to as 'BNS' for short). The petitioner has been in judicial custody since 06.04.2026.
2. The Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submitted that he was innocent and had not committed any offence. It was also submitted that petitioner had not filed bail petition of any sort earlier this court or either before any superior court. It was also submitted that the petitioner has no criminal antecedent. It was also submitted that the petitioner filed a bail petition before lower court and same has been rejected on 08.04.2026. It was also submitted that the petitioner never kidnapped the victim. It was further submitted that the petitioner has been arrested by the police and rotting in jail since 06.04.2026. It was submitted that the petitioner was ready to abide by the condition(s) imposed upon him by the learned court. The learned counsel prayed for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.
3. The Learned Public Prosecutor opposed the petition and prayed to reject it.
4. Heard both the sides, perused the case record and the Learned Trial Court Record.
5. The allegation against the petitioner is that he along with other accused persons kidnapped the minor daughter of the informant with an intent to marry her.
6. The victim stated to have married the petitioner and her parents also not imputed anything against the petitioner in their statement. The charge sheet has been submitted in this case. The petitioner has been in judicial custody since 06.04.2026.
7. In the facts and circumstances as discussed above, the instant regular bail petition filed on behalf of the petitioner namely **Krishn Yadav @ Krishna Yadav** is hereby **allowed**. The petitioner is directed to be released on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of like amount each with an undertaking under Section 480(3) of the BNSS subject to the satisfaction of the Learned Jurisdictional Court.
8. It is made clear that this order has no bearing on the merits of the case.
9. Let a copy of this order be sent to the concerned Jurisdictional Court.
