ORDER

08.05.2026

1. The petitioner above named sought regular bail in connection with Town PS Case No 221 of 2025 registered for the offence under Sections 126(2), 115(2), 118(1), 109, 3(5) of the Bhartiya Nyay Sanhita (hereinafter referred to as 'BNS' for short). The petitioner has been in judicial custody since 04.04.2026.
2. The Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submitted that he was innocent and had not committed any offence. It was also submitted that prior to it an anticipatory bail has been filed on behalf of the petitioner which was rejected by Hon'ble ASJ-1st, Darbhanga via ABP No. 39/2026 dated 23.03.2026 and thereafter petitioner had not filed bail petition of any sort earlier this court or either before any superior court. It was also submitted that the petitioner has clean antecedent. It was also submitted that a bail petition has been filed on behalf of the petitioner in the court of CJM, Darbhanga and the same was rejected on 10.04.2026. It was further submitted that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case due to previous enmity and personal grudge. It was further alleged that all sections are bail-able except 109, BNS which is not made out against the petitioner. It was submitted that the petitioner was ready to abide by the condition(s) imposed upon him by the learned court. The learned counsel prayed for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.
3. The Learned Public Prosecutor opposed the petition and prayed to reject it.
4. Heard both the sides, perused the case record and the Learned Trial Court Record.
5. The allegation against the petitioner is that he along with his five other colleagues with an intent to kill him gave various knife blows to the informant's son Ashutosh. The blood gushed out profusely, Ashutosh fell down and taken to DMCH for treatment but subsequently preferred to Patna for better treatment.
6. There is direct allegation against the petitioner to assault the injured with sharp-edged weapon. The injury report of injured Ashutosh shows incised wounds over his right cheek, right side of lower lip, left eye, left mandible, medial canthus of left eye, root of nose, left cheek, nape of the neck, right hypochondrium (upper lateral

region of abdomen), right lumbar, four perforation near supra umbilical region, liver laceration. The injuries are found to be grievous in nature.

7. Though the petitioner has been in custody since 04.04.2026 but taking into account the voluminous sharp cut injuries over different parts of the injured person and its grievous nature, I am not inclined to enlarge him on bail. In the result, the bail petition filed on behalf of the petitioner namely **Himesh Kumar @ Himesh Sahni** stands **rejected**.
8. It is made clear that this order has no bearing on the merits of the case.
9. Let a copy of this order be sent to the concerned Jurisdictional Court.
10. Let this case record be deposited in the Record Room, Civil Court, Darbhanga after all due diligence.
