ORDER

10.06.2026

1. The surrender-cum-bail petition dated 10.06.2026 filed on behalf of the accused **Sudhir Sharma** was conducted today.
2. The Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner was innocent and had committed no offence and falsely implicated in this case. It was submitted that no anticipatory bail or regular bail has been either before this court or before the Hon'ble High court and no any such application is pending in any court. It was further submitted that the petitioner has clean antecedent. It was also submitted that prosecution case is totally false and baseless and no such occurrence took place as alleged by the prosecution. It was further submitted that no offence U/s 27(d) /28A of drugs and cosmetics Act are made out against the petitioner as there is no violation of rules of drugs and cosmetics. It was also submitted that although all the offences are bailable. The learned counsel prayed to enlarge the petitioner on bail.
3. The Learned Special Public Prosecutor opposed the petition and prayed to reject it.
4. The allegation against the petitioner is that during inspection, inspecting team found FDC was being sold which was irrational and not in accordance with

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law.

5. The cognizance of the alleged has already been taken in the case on the basis of prosecution report . No custodial interrogation is required.
6. Taking into account the facts and circumstances mentioned above **Sudhir Sharma,** is hereby **allowed.** The petitioner is directed to be released on furnishing a bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of like amount with further condition that the petitioner should be Proper parvi in the court on each date.
