ORDER

10.06.2026

1. The petitioner above named sought anticipatory bail in connection with Moro P.S. Case No. 29/2026 registered for the offences under Section 126(2), 115(2), 109, 76, 303(2), 352, 351(2), 3(5) of the Bhartiya Nyay Sanhita (hereinafter referred to as 'BNS' for short).
2. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submitted that he was innocent and had not committed any offence. It was further submitted that petitioner had not filed bail petition of any sort earlier this court or either before any superior court. It was also submitted that the petitioner has no criminal antecedent. It was also submitted that the entire allegation as alleged by the prosecution is false concocted and baseless. It was also submitted the the petitioner is old ailing visually and as such he is not able to walk and he is the member of mob. It was also submitted that the petitioner had been implicated in this false case due to grudge and malice and village politics. It was also submitted that there is general and omnibus allegation and nothing specific anymore. It was also submitted that all the sections are bailable except section 76, 109, 303(2) BNS and there is no allegation of disrobed, and no allegation of theft and as such u/s 76, 303(2) BNS is made out against the petitioner. It was submitted that the petitioner was ready to abide by the condition(s) imposed upon him by the learned court. The learned counsel prayed for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.
3. Learned Public Prosecutor opposed the petition and prayed to reject it
4. Heard both the sides, perused the case record as well as the case diary.
5. The prosecution case according to FIR in brief is that he along with other accused persons assaulted the informant, when he came with other villagers to inquire into the allegation of alleged rape. On the order given by the petitioner the other accused persons assaulted the informant with iron rod. The petitioner is alleged to have assaulted the informant with iron rod on his body and head. When villagers Jahana and Nizam came to save him, they were also assaulted. The accused persons also assaulted informant's brother and the petitioner took out Rs. 1000/-

from informant brother's pocket. The injured persons were taken to DMCH for treatment.

6. There is no specific allegation against the petitioner to commit any overt act. No statement of the alleged rape victim is recorded by the IO in the course of investigation. The petitioner has no criminal antecedent.
7. In facts and circumstances as stated above, the instant anticipatory bail petition filed on behalf of the petitioner namely **Nazre Alam @ Md Sajid** is hereby **allowed**. In the event of arrest or surrender by the petitioner within 21 (Twenty One) days of receipt/production of this order, he is directed to be released on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Learned Jurisdictional Court concerned with an undertaking as stipulated under Section 482(2) of the BNSS with a further condition that he will not involve in the offence of similar nature in future.
8. It is made clear that this order has no bearing on the merits of the case.
9. Let a copy of this order be sent to the concerned Jurisdictional Court.
10. Let this case record be deposited in the Record Room, Civil Court, Darbhanga after all due diligence.
