ORDER

20.07.2026

1. The petitioner above named sought anticipatory bail in connection with Jalley P.S. Case No 97/26 registered for the offences under Section 61(2), 96, 137(2), 352, 351(2), 3(5) of the Bhartiya Nyay Sanhita (hereinafter referred to as 'BNS' for short).
2. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submitted that he was innocent and had not committed any offence. It was further submitted that petitioner had not filed bail petition of any sort earlier before this court or either before any superior court. It was also submitted that the petitioner had no criminal antecedent. It was further submitted that the petitioner had been falsely implicated in this case due to love affair between the victim and son of the petitioner and both are minor also. It was also alleged that no offence u/s 61(2), 96, 137(2) BNS is made out against the petitioner. It was submitted that the petitioner was ready to abide by the condition(s) imposed upon him by the learned court. The learned counsel prayed for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.
3. Learned Public Prosecutor opposed the petition and prayed to reject it.
4. Heard both the sides, perused the case record and the case diary.
5. The allegation against the petitioner is that he along with other accused persons kidnapped the minor maternal granddaughter of the informant. When the informant remonstrated, the petitioner is alleged to have verbally abused and threatened him.
6. From the certificate issued by the school, the victim girl was about 16 years of age on the alleged date of occurrence. The victim girl has not been recovered yet.
7. Though the petitioner has no criminal antecedent but taking into account the facts and the circumstances particularly the non-recovery of the victim girl, I do not find it a fit case to grant him the privilege of anticipatory bail. In the result, the instant anticipatory bail petition filed on behalf of the petitioner namely **Vijay Kumar Singh @ Vijay Pd. Singh** stands **rejected**.
8. It is made clear that this order has no bearing on the merits of the case.
