ORDER

16.06.2026

1. The petitioners above named sought anticipatory bail in connection with Singhwara P.S. Case No. 162/26 registered for the offences under Section 137(2), 96, 352, 351(2), 3(5) of the Bhartiya Nyay Sanhita (hereinafter referred to as 'BNS' for short).
2. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners submitted that they were innocent and had not committed any offence. It was further submitted that petitioners had not filed bail petition of any sort earlier before this court or either before any superior court. It was also submitted that the petitioners have no criminal antecedent. It was further submitted that the allegation against these petitioners were totally false, baseless and concocted. It was further submitted that the informant had filed this false case due to misunderstanding. It was further submitted that the petitioners have no manner of concern with the occurrence as alleged in the FIR. It was further alleged that the petitioners have also no manner of concern with the missing of the minor daughter of the informant. It was also submitted that the informant and his antisocial elements came inside the house of the petitioners assaulted abuses and snatched the valuable articles of the informant and female members also abuses and disrobed the prestige and to put pressure to the petitioners. It was submitted that the petitioners were ready to abide by the condition(s) imposed upon him by the learned court. The learned counsel prayed for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners.
3. Learned Public Prosecutor opposed the petition and prayed to reject it.
4. Heard both the sides, perused the case record and the Learned Trial Court Record.

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5. The allegation against the petitioners is that they along with other accused persons seduced and kidnapped the minor daughter of the informant. When the informant complained, then they verbally abused and threatened her.
6. There is no allegation of kidnapping against these petitioners except that they alleged to have threatened the informant. The victim in her statement u/s 183 of the BNSS has not imputed anything against the petitioners.
7. In the facts and circumstances as discussed above, the instant anticipatory bail petition filed on behalf of the petitioners namely **1. Upendra Chaupal, 2. Kailasiya Devi, 3. Nitu Kumari and 4. Sanjay Chaupal** is hereby **allowed**. In the event of arrest or surrender by the petitioners within 21 (Twenty One) days of receipt/production of this order, they are directed to be released on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Learned Jurisdictional Court concerned with an undertaking as stipulated under Section 482(2) of the BNSS.
8. It is made clear that this order has no bearing on the merits of the case.
9. Let a copy of this order be sent to the concerned Jurisdictional Court.
10. Let this case record be deposited in the Record Room, Civil Court, Darbhanga after all due diligence.
