ORDER

12-06-2026: Application for regular bail has been filed on behalf of the petitioner namely Abhishek Kumar @ Abhishek Soni, who is in judicial custody since 18-04-2026 in connection with Darbhanga Town P.S. Case No. 72/2026 for the offences U/ss. 310(2), 311 of the Bhartiya Nyay Sanhita, pressed today.

2. Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned Public Prosecutor on behalf of the State.

3. The allegation is that on the alleged date of occurrence on 03.04.2026 at about 2.40 PM the informant was at his jewellery shop namely Prem Jewellers at Bara Bazar PS.-Town District Darbhanga, in the meantime 5-6 accused persons entered into the Jewellery shop of the informant and started to commit loot and on protest made by the informant, his son Prem Kumar and two staffs as well as customers, the culprits shown the pistol, gave threatening to kill them. It has further alleged that the culprits started to assault them brutally and they gathered them in a corner and they looted away gold jewellery about 700 gram and silver ornaments 20-25 Kg and they looted away ornaments of Rs.8,00,000/- and cash, total of Rs. 10,00,000/- from one customer Randhir Thakur and they fled away giving threatening that if they told about the occurrence to any other, then they kill the informant and his entire family members and they closed the gate of the shop from outside. The culprits also took away 8 Mobile Phones, leading to the institution of the present case.

4 It is submitted on behalf of the petitioner that the petitioner is quite innocent, has committed no offence and has falsely been implicated in this case. It is

further submitted that by perusal of the First Information Report it appears admitted that the present First Information Report has been instituted against five unknown and the petitioner is not named in the First Information Report and only on the basis of confessional statement of co-accused the petitioner has been made accused in this case, which has no legal value. The further submission is that petitioner carries clean antecedent and is languishing in custody since 10-04-2026. Hence, she may be granted the privilege of regular bail.

5. On the other hand, the learned Public Prosecutor opposes the prayer for regular bail.

6. Heard and perused the case diary. Para no. 19 of the case diary is the description of place of occurrence which appears situated at a place in Bara Bazar, Town PS District Darbhanga. Para-20,21,22,23 of the case diary reflects the statement of witnesses supporting the occurrence. Para-30 of the case diary reflects confessional statement of Aryan Kumar(co-accused) where he disclosed the name of all above 18 persons including the petitioner as his associates committing crime. Para -31 of the case diary reflects confessional statement of Pawan Jha. Para- 36 of the case diary reflects recovery of 8 mobile phones and A.C. remotes on the basis of confession of Pawan Kumar Jha. Para-39 of the case reflects recovery of two motorcycles. Para-42 is the requisition for the CDR and some of mobile numbers disclosed by the co-accused Pawan Jha and Aryan Kumar. Para no.59 of the case diary reflects some recovery from co-accused Pawan Jha, Aryan Kumar, where country-made pistol is also alleged to have recovered. Para no. 63 is the Confessional Statement of co-accused Deepak Kumar. Para no. 87 reflects the recovery of some of the looted articles on the basis of confession of accused-petitioner Abhishek Soni, who later on confessed his complicity. Para no. 92 also reflects recovery of some of the looted ornaments at the instance of accused petitioner Abhishek Kumar Soni. Para no.97 reflects the raided in the house of accused Usha Devi searching her

son Sandip Kumar one of the suspect and it is stated that on query, the accused Usha Devi disclose that some of the looted articles have been kept at the orchard under the soil which was recovered. Para no.132 of the case diary reflects the arrest of co-accused Nitish Kumar Singh @ Lalu Singh, who confessed his complicity and on the basis of which the jewellery shop of co-accused Vikash Kumar Soni was raided, where it is alleged that altogether 2160 gram of looted jewellery has been recovered and seized. Para 169 of the case diary reflects clean antecedent of the petitioner. The investigation is under progress.

7. Under the facts and circumstances of the present case, where the petitioner has found to be involved in a case of dacoity committed in Bara Bazar under Town police station in a broad day light and committed loot in the jewellery shop and some of the looted ornaments and items have been recovered on the instance of accused petitioner, the Court is not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner at this stage, which consequently stands **rejected**.
