ORDER

22.08.2026

1. The petitioner above named sought anticipatory bail in connection with Manigacchi P.S. Case No. 17/2026 registered for the offences under Section 87, 137(2), 3(5) of the Bhartiya Nyay Sanhita (hereinafter referred to as 'BNS' for short).
2. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submitted that she was innocent and had not committed any offence. It was further submitted that petitioner had not filed bail petition of any sort earlier before this court or either before any superior court. It was also submitted that there was no criminal antecedent against this petitioner. It was further stated that the petitioner is quite innocent and she has not committed any offence as alleged by the informant. It was also submitted that the entire allegation levelled against the petitioner are false and concocted and alleged only to capture the land of the petitioners and Title Suit is also pending between the families of both parties. It was alleged that the alleged victim girl Radha Kumari has been recovered and her statement u/s 183 of BNSS has been recorded before the court. It was also submitted that the petitioner is a lady. It was submitted that the petitioner was ready to abide by the condition(s) imposed upon him by the learned court. The learned counsel prayed for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.
3. Learned Public Prosecutor opposed the petition and prayed to reject it.
4. Heard both the sides, perused the case record and the Learned Trial Court Record.
5. The allegation against the petitioner is that he along with other accused persons kidnapped the minor daughter of the informant with an intent to marry.
6. The victim is a minor on the date of alleged incident and her date of birth is 09.11.2008. The victim in her statement u/s 180 of the BNSS stated that it was the petitioner called her and told her to elope with him to marry. Though in her statement u/s 183 of the BNSS she retracted from her earlier statement. Consent of a minor is of no relevance in the offence of such nature.

Though the petitioner has no criminal antecedent but taking into account, facts, circumstances and nature of allegation, I do not find it a fit case to grant him the privilege of anticipatory bail. In the result, the instant anticipatory bail petition filed on behalf of the petitioner namely **Md. Kamaluddin Ansari @ Isha** stands **rejected**.
8. It is made clear that this order has no bearing on the merits of the case.
9. Let a copy of this order be sent to the concerned Jurisdictional Court.
10. Let this case record be deposited in the Record Room, Civil Court, Darbhanga after all due diligence.
