ORDER

19.06.2026

1. The surrender-cum-bail petition dated 19.06.2026 filed on behalf of the accused Manish Kumar was conducted today.
2. The Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner was innocent and had committed no offence and falsely implicated in this case. It was submitted that no anticipatory bail or regular bail has been either before this court or before the Hon'ble High court and no any such application is pending in any court. That the petitioner is also accused in keoti P.s No. - 254/2025. That one Mitubala Drug Inspector gave one typed Prosecution report and its basis this case has been registered and after Cognizance under section- 27(b)(ii) of Drugs and Cosmetics Act. That in short the case of informant is that shop Manish Medical Hall is being run by the petitioner as different place other than for which licence is granted, without licence. It was further submitted that the allegations against this petitioner are ornamental and does not constitute offence under Section- 27(b)(ii) of Drugs and Cosmetics Act. The learned counsel prayed to enlarge the petitioner on bail.

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3. The Learned Special Public Prosecutor opposed the petition and prayed to reject it.
4. The allegation against the petitioner is that during inspection, he was found selling medicine without a valid license.
5. The cognizance of the alleged has already been taken in the case on the basis of prosecution report . No custodial interrogation is required.
6. Taking into account the facts and circumstances mentioned above **Manish Kumar** is hereby **allowed**. The petitioner is directed to be released on furnishing a bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of like amount with further condition that the petitioner should be well represented in the court on each date.
