ORDER

18.07.2026 The present application for anticipatory bail has been filed on behalf of petitioners namely 1.Sulendar Tanti @ Surendar Tanti, aged about 48 years, S/o Jago Tanti, 2.Ravi Kishun Tanti, aged about 20 years, S/o Sulendar Tanti, 3.Sattan Tanti, aged about 35 years, s/o Bahadur Tanti, 4.Bahadur Tanti, aged about 46 years, s/o Mandal Tanti, 5.Yogendar Tanti, aged about 72 years, s/o Ramdeo Tanti, 6.Raja Tanti, aged about 33 years, s/o Bhulo Tanti, 7.Rajesh Tanti, aged about 26 years, s/o Dinesh Tanti, 8.Narain Tanti @ Nayan Tanti, aged about 25 years, s/o Sikandar Tanti @ Sukhendar Tanti and 9.Sikandar Tanti @ Sukhendar Tanti, aged about 63 years, s/o Sathu Tanti, All R/o village – Jayantipur, P.S.- Bahera, Dist.- Darbhanga, in connection with Bahera P.S Case No. 71/2026, u/s 126(2), 115(2), 118(1), 191(2), 191(3), 190, 109, 324(2), 351(2), 352 of BNS, which is pending in the Court of A.C.J.M., Benipur, Darbhanga.

Heard Sri Azad Alam, Ld. Counsel for the petitioner and Sri Choudhary Shyam Chandra Rai, Ld. A.P.P. on behalf of the State.

The Counsel for the petitioners has submitted that due to intervention of well wishers of both the parties, the case has been compromised between the parties outside the court. That in view of the compromise the petitioners do not want to proceed with the case further. That the further proceeding of the case may cause unnecessary physical financial & mental harassment to these petitioners. That good feelings have been restored in between the parties. That in token of the acceptance of the compromise the parties & their respective lawyers have signed over the compromise petition. It is therefore prayed that accept the compromise petition and and acquit the accused person.

On the other hand Ld. APP appearing for the State has opposed the prayer for bail and submitted that the offense is grave in nature. Hence, the anticipatory bail petition of the petitioner may be rejected.

Heard, Submissions of both parties and perused the record. During the course of hearing accused person as well as informant appeared before court and the informant said that dispute has been settled between the parties. They also filed the copy of compromise petition executed by the informant as well

as petitioner before the court of Ld. ACJM, Benipur. That the informant Gulzar Alam appeared before court and submitted that he would not give any evidence against the petitioners even during the trial. That as informant is submitting to not to give any evidence against petitioners even during the trial, it is meaningless to keep the sword of arrest hanging on the petitioners. So in the light of these facts and circumstances and with discussions made hereinbefore, this Court finds it proper to allow the anticipatory bail petition of this petitioners namely 1.**Sulendar Tanti @ Surendar Tanti**, aged about 48 years, S/o Jago Tanti, 2.**Ravi Kishun Tanti**, aged about 20 years, S/o Sulendar Tanti, 3.**Sattan Tanti**, aged about 35 years, s/o Bahadur Tanti, 4.**Bahadur Tanti**, aged about 46 years, s/o Mandal Tanti, 5.**Yogendar Tanti**, aged about 72 years, s/o Ramdeo Tanti, 6.**Raja Tanti**, aged about 33 years, s/o Bhulo Tanti, 7.**Rajesh Tanti**, aged about 26 years, s/o Dinesh Tanti, 8.**Narain Tanti @ Nayan Tanti**, aged about 25 years, s/o Sikindar Tanti @ Sukhendar Tanti and 9.**Sikandar Tanti @ Sukhendar Tanti**, aged about 63 years, s/o Sathu Tanti, All R/o village – Jayantipur, P.S.- Bahera, Dist.- Darbhanga. That in case of arrest or surrender within a period of three weeks of receiving of this order by the Ld. Court below, the accused petitioners is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/-(Rs. Ten Thousands/-) with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of the court below and with the condition that accused petitioners shall cooperate in investigation and trial.
