ORDER

08.06.2026 The present anticipatory bail petition has been filed on behalf of petitioners namely 1.Bishundeo Ram, S/o Late Jagdish Ram, 2.Lalanjee Ram @ Lalan Kumar Ram, S/o Bishundeo Ram, 3.Geeta Devi, W/o Bishundeo Ram All resident of village – Benipur, P.S. Bahera – Distt. - Darbhanga, who are apprehending their arrests in connection with Bahera P.S. Case No. 04/2026 for offence u/s 126(2), 115(2), 118(1), 117(2), 74, 109, 303(2), 351(2), 352, 3(5) of BNS, which is pending in the court of Ld. A.C.J.M., Benipur.

Heard Sri Amit Kumar, Ld. Counsel for the petitioners and Smt. Punam Jha, Ld. Counsel for the state.

The prosecution case as stated in brief is that on 23.12.2025 at around 7-8 PM when informant and his family members were at their home, accused persons Bishundeo Ram, Shyam Ram, Anurag Ranjan, Lalanjee Ram and Geeta Devi carrying rod and garasa entered in their house and started to abuse. That accused persons were shouting to kill informant and Bhagwanday Devi. That accused Bishundeo Ram ordered to kill all. That on the said call, Lalanjee Ram and Shyam Ram attacked informant with iron rod and injured head, eyebrow, face and body of him. That when informant's wife intervened, accused Geeta Devi pulled her down by pulling her hairs. That accused Bishundeo Ram, Anurag Ram, Lalanjee Ram injured her face, nose, other parts of body while her leg got fractured. That the reason of incident was that earlier informant filed a case Bahera P.S. No. 475/23 and as informant did not compromise the same, accused persons intimidated them of dire consequences.

The Counsel for the petitioners has submitted that this application for grant of anticipatory bail on behalf of the above named petitioners who are apprehending their arrest at the hand of police on a false accusation of having committed a non-bailable offence. That prior to this petition, no bail either anticipatory or regular on behalf of the above named petitioners have been filed either in this court or before the Hon'ble High Court, Patna and nor such type of petition is pending anywhere. That the petitioners are not named accused in any other case. That the petitioners have no criminal antecedent except Bahera PS case no. 475/2023. That the petitioners are innocent and have committed no offence.

That the allegation leveled against the petitioners are bailable except the allegation u/s 118(1), 74, 109, 303(2) of BNS. That so far the allegation u/s 118(1), 74, 109, 303(2) of BNS is concerned, there is no ingredients in facts and circumstances and it was only added to make the case serious in nature and non-bailable and from the perusal of FIR your honor will find that no case is made out under alleged sections against the petitioners. That, the entire allegation leveled against the petitioners are false, concocted and absurd one. That the petitioners are men and woman of sufficient means and they are ready to abide by all the condition which may imposed by Ld. Court. That the petitioners are ready to furnish bail bonds to the satisfaction of the court. Hence, it was prayed that the accused petitioners may be granted bail.

On the other hand Ld. Counsel of the informant has opposed the prayer for bail submitting that the offences are grave in nature, hence the bail petition of the petitioners may be rejected.

Heard, Submissions of both parties and perused the record. From perusal of record, it has been found that this case has been filed u/s 126(2), 115(2), 118(1), 117(2), 74, 109, 303(2), 351(2), 352, 3(5) of BNS. That allegation against Bishundeo Ram and Lalanjee Ram is specific that they attacked with iron rod and injured informant and his wife and both of them have criminal antecedent of similar nature. That injury report of Bhagwandai is on record showing swelling on fronto-temporal region and NCCT was also advised. So, this court is **not inclined to grant bail to petitioner No.1 Bishundeo Ram, S/o Late Jagdish Ram & petitioner No.2 Lalanjee Ram @ Lalan Kumar Ram, S/o Bishundeo Ram**, both resident of village – Benipur, P.S. Bahera – Distt. - Darbhanga. As far as petitioner No.3 is concerned, the allegation against her is only that she pulled Bhagwandai on the ground from hairs and of theft while in charge-sheet there is no recovery as such. So, considering the discussion made and under these circumstances, this court finds it proper **to allow the bail petition of the petitioners No. 3. Geeta Devi, W/o Bishundeo Ram**, resident of village – Benipur, P.S. Bahera – Distt. - Darbhanga only. That in case of arrest or surrender within a period of three weeks of receipt of this order by the concerned court, the accused petitioner is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Rs. Ten Thousands/-) with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of the court below and with the condition that petitioner No. 3 shall cooperate in investigation and trial.
