**ORDER**

**16.03.2026** The present anticipatory bail petition has been filed on behalf of petitioners who are apprehending their arrest namely 1.Paramanand Yadav, S/o Late Uge Yadav, 2.Pramod Kumar Yadav, S/o Baleshwar Yadav, 3.Manohar Yadav, S/o Kari Yadav in connection with Ghanshyampur PS Case No- 334/2025, for offence u/s 109, 115(1), 124(2), 115(2), 253, 304(1), 309(1), 129, 61, 102 of BNS which is pending in the Court of Ld. JMFC, Sri. R.K. Deepak, Biraul, Darbhanga.

Heard Sri Ram Chandra Yadav, the Ld. Counsel for the petitioner and Sri Bachcha Rai, Ld. APP on behalf of the State.

The prosecution case in short is that, on 04.07.2025 at about 11:30 PM, the informant Krishna Kumar Sahu and his whole family was sleeping of his house in the mean time the petitioners along with some unknown persons came variously armed with dangerous weapons and JCB and broke the wall of the house of the informant by JCB and began to assault his family members. The said informant attempted to inform but they broke his mobile on which Bhagia Devi and Gangia Devi gave an application to the Ghanshyampur police but no any action has been taken against them. Again on 09.07.2025 at about 7 PM the petitioners along with 8-10 persons came variously armed with dangerous weapons and JCB and began to threaten him to excent his land since he has land behind his land on which the informant refused to do so. They gave a iron rod on his foot in the mean while the mother of the informant namely Nilam Devi came to rescue him but petitioner no-2 Pramod

Yadav caught hold her and put down her on the earth and petitioner No-1 Parmanand Yadav and Petitioner No-3 Manohar Yadav torn her cloth and necked her. That further the case of prosecution as alleged interalia is that on Bhagia Devi is aged about 70 years forbade them to enter into her house on which petitioner no-1 Paramanand Yadav put rope in to her neck with an intention to kill her and further they taken away Jewellery and other costly house hold articles.

The Ld. Counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have not committed any offence and they are quite innocent. The petitioners have falsely been implicated in this false case at the instance of the enemies. That no such occurrence did ever take place as alleged in FIR. That all the alleged offences are bailable save and except offences u/s 109, 124, 253, 304, 102 of BNS which have not attracting against these petitioners. For that the petitioners are men of means and not likely to abscond and is ready to furnish the bail bonds to the satisfaction of the court, as such there is no chance of their absconding. So, it is prayed that accused person may be enlarge on bail.

On the other hand Ld. APP appearing for the State opposed the prayer for bail of the petitioner.

Heard, Submissions of both parties and perused the record and considering the discussion made above, The offence is u/s 109, 115(1), 124(2), 115(2), 253, 304(1), 309(1), 129, 61, 102 of BNS in which section 109, 124, 253, 304, 102 of BNS is non bailable in nature. From the perusal of F.I.R. the petitioners are named accused in this case with direct allegation that they came variously armed with dangerous weapons and JCB and broke the wall of the house of the informant by JCB and began to assault his family members. Petitioner No-2 Pramod Yadav caught hold the informant's mother and put down her on the earth and petitioner No-1 Parmanand Yadav and Petitioner No-3 Manohar Yadav torn her cloth and necked her when she came to rescue her son. The offences alleged against the accused petitioner is serious in nature and considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case as well as gravity of offence I am not inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail, the present anticipatory bail petition of the petitioners namely, 1. Paramanand Yadav, S/o Late Uge Yadav, 2. Pramod Kumar Yadav, S/o Baleshwar Yadav, 3. Manohar Yadav, S/o Kari Yadav, ABP is hereby **Rejected**. In connection with Ghanshyampur PS Case No- 334/2025.
