ORDER

24.03.2026 The present bail petition has been filed on behalf of petitioner namely 1.Ramesh Paswan, S/o Ram Bharosh Paswan who is in judicial custody since 09.02.2026 in connection with Biraul P.S. Case No- 400/2024, for offence u/s 331(4), 305(A) of BNS which is pending in the Court of Ld. ACJM-I, Biraul, Darbhanga.

Heard Sri Ram Bilash Yadav, the Ld. Counsel for the petitioner and Sri Bachcha Rai, Ld. APP on behalf of the State.

The prosecution case in short is that, on 24.10.2024 at 1:30 PM, in night, informant went to sleep in the house, three unknown entered in the house of informant and attempted to commit theft but informant awoke and caught the accused/thives and recovered box from his possession.

The Ld. Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has not committed any offence and they are innocent. The petitioner has falsely been implicated in this false. For that the above named petitioner who is in judicial custody since 09.02.2026 and sufficiently punished of offence that he has not committed. That no such occurrence did ever take place as alleged in FIR. That there is no criminal antecedent against the

petitioner. For that the petitioner is class of labour. For that co-accused person granted bail. For that there is no articles recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. For that the petitioner is man of means and not likely to abscond and is ready to furnish the bail bonds to the satisfaction of the court, as such there is no chance of their absconding. So, it is prayed that accused person may be enlarge on bail.

On the other hand Ld. APP appearing for the State opposed the prayer for bail of the petitioner.

Heard, Submissions of both parties and perused the record and considering the discussion made above. The petitioner accused has been remanded on 09.02.2026 on the basis of the petition filed by the I.O., the petitoiner has no any criminal antecedent as stated by the Ld. Counsel for the petitioner. From the perusal entire facts it seems that no articles have been recovered from the possession of the petitioner. The co-accused person granted bail. Therefore considering the custody period, submissions made by the Ld. counsel for petitioner and the fact as well as other facts and circumstances of the case the present bail petition filed on behalf of petitioner namely 1.Ramesh Paswan, S/o Ram Bharosh Paswan, BP is hereby **Allowed**. 1.Ramesh Paswan, S/o Ram Bharosh Paswan is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/-(Rs. Ten Thousands/-) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the court in connection with Biraul P.S. Case No- 400/2024.
