**29.04.2026** The present anticipatory bail petition has been filed on behalf of abovenamed petitioners who are apprehending their arrest in connection with Ghanshyampur PS case NO. 122 of 2025, for the offences U/Ss 96, 303(2), 3(5) of BNS, which is pending in the Court of Rakesh Kumar Deepak JMFC, Biraoul, Darbhanga.

Heard Sri Yoga Nand Jha the Ld. Counsel for the petitioner and Sri Bachcha Rai Ld. Counsel for State.

The FIR in the present case has been lodged on the basis of application of informant namely Mukesh Paswan. The case of the prosecution in brief is that on 18.04.2025 at around 11 O'clock the accused persons as mentioned in the FIR including petitioners seduced

sister of informant namely Sabita Kumari who is 16 years in age and kidnapped her with ill intentions. The sister of informant had also taken gold worth of Rs. 25,000/- with her.

Ld. Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioners are quite innocent and they have not committed any offence. The petitioners have falsely been implicated in this false case. No case under the alleged sections of FIR has been made out against the petitioners. The petitioner has no manner of concern with the alleged incident. All the allegations as leveled in the FIR are false, concocted and omnibus in nature. The petitioners are ready to abide by all the conditions as imposed by the court. Therefore the present petition may be allowed.

On the other hand Ld. Counsel for State opposed the prayer for bail.

Upon considering the rival submissions and on perusal of the materials available on record this court finds that statement of victim recorded u/s 183 BNSS is attached with the records from perusal whereof it appears that she is in love with one Vikram Sahani and on the date of incident she with her own sweet will left the house and solemnize marriage with Vikram Sahani at Shimla. In her statement recorded u/s 183 BNSS no whisper has been made against these petitioners. Considering the submissions made at bar, discussions made above and also considering the fact that the victim in her statement recorded u/s 183 BNSS has not stated anything against these petitioners as well as other facts and circumstances of the case the prayer for anticipatory bail of the above-named petitioners is **allowed**. The petitioners are directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Rs. Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each in the event of their arrest by police
